Order

03.06.2026 The present anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of abovenamed petitioners who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Biraul PS case No. 225 of 2026 for the offences u/s 329(3), 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS, which is pending in the Court of Ld. ACJM, Biraul, Darbhanga.

Heard Sri Sashikant Roy the Ld. Counsel for the petitioners and Sri Bachcha Rai Ld. Counsel for State.

The present case has been lodged on the basis of application of informant namely Raju Baitha. The case of the prosecution in brief is that on 19.04.2026 at around 10 AM petitioners armed with lathi danda, iron rod and started abusing informant and his mother. Lakki Khan assaulted informant with iron rod on his head. Accused persons have also assaulted him in fallen state. After that he has taken to PHC, Biraul.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioners are quite innocent and he has not committed any offence. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in this false case. All the alleged sections areailable save and except offence u/s 118(1) of BNS which is not made out in this case. Petitioner No. 1 lodged Biraul PS case No. 226/26 on 20.04.2026 against informant of the persent case. The petitiner no. 2 has no manner of concern. Both the parties have amicably settled their dispute and they have compromise the case. The petitioners are ready to abide by all the condition as imposed by the Court. Therefore the present petition may be allowed.

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On the other hand, Ld. Addl. P.P appearing on behalf of the State though opposed the prayer for bail but admitted the factum of compromise.

Upon considering the rival submissions and on perusal of the materials available on record this court finds that both the parties have amicably settled their dispute and the informant has no objection if the anticipatory bail petition of petitioners are allowed. Considering the submissions made at bar, discussions made above, factum of compromise as well as other facts and circumstances of the case the prayer for anticipatory bail of the aforesaid petitioners is **allowed**. The petitioners are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each in the event of their arrest by police or surrender before Ld. Court below within a period of three weeks from the receipt of copy of this order in connection with Biraul PS case No. 225/26 to the satisfaction of learned Court below subject to the conditions laid down u/s 482(2) of BNSS.
