ORDER

22.07.2026: Application for anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioners namely **Subhash Ram, Amarjeet Ram, Rajesh Ram, Sandip Ram, Saroj Raj, Rajiya Devi, Asha Devi, Rahul Ram, Bimla Devi, Pradeep Ram, Badari Ram, Sakal Dip Ram, Ramchandra Ram, Ganauri Devi, Laxman Ram, Raju Ram, Shankar Ram and Arun Ram**, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Ghanshyampur PS Case No. 61 of 2026 for the offences U/Ss. 115(2), 126(2), 110, 190, 191(2), 352, 351(2) of the BNS, pressed today.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Public Prosecutor for the State.

3. The allegation is that on the alleged date of occurrence of 17.02.2026 at 4.00 PM the informant was constructing toilet in his land and his neighbour Soni Khatoon was also present there. Meanwhile accused Indu Kumari called other co-accused, upon which accused Ram Chandra Ram Laxman Ram, Badri Ram, Pradeep Ram, Amit Ram, Sandip Ram, Amarjeet Ram, Sakaldeep Ram, Shankar Ram, Rajesh Ram, Rahul Ram, Raju Ram, Vimla Devi, Ganauri Devi, Rajiya Devi, Aasha Devi, Pramila Devi, Maniya

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Devi, Babita Devi, Arun Ram, duly armed with various weapons attacked upon the informant and his family members. Accused Amarjeet assaulted him with iron rod, Shakaldeep Ram assaulted him with axe. When informant's mother Shyama Devi came to save her then accused Ramchandar Ram assaulted her with Dabiya and accused Rajesh Ram assaulted her with Tengari. It is alleged that accused Laxman Ram, Rahul Ram, Subhash Ram, Pradeep Ram, Amit Ram assaulted informant's brother Manoj Ram with khanti, blunt portion of spade and rod, causing injury. It is alleged that accused Saroj Ram, Shankar Ram, Vimla Devi, Rina Devi assaulted informant's brother Arjun Ram. When informant's wife Triphula Devi came to save him, accused person namely accused Sandeep Ram assaulted her with spade. Accused Arun Ram, Maniya Devi assaulted informant's sister-in-law(Bhabhi) Shanti Devi with Dabiya, causing injury to her. The injured were taken to PHC, Kiratpur for treatment, leading into the institution of the case.

4. It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that the petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence and have falsely been implicated in the present case. It has further been submitted that no occurrence as alleged in the First Information Report has ever taken place rather the present case is outcome of ill-mechanism at the behest of the informant. Further submission is that even if the allegation in the First Information Report has gospel truth about the occurrence, no offence u/s 110 of the BNS is attracted in wants of constituting ingredients. The further submission is that there is case and counter case between the parties as such Ghanshyampur P.S. Case No. 62 of 2026 instituted at behest of wife of accused petitioner Badri Ram against the informant side and only to save skin from the above case the present case has been maliciously been instituted. Moreover, the investigation has already been completed ruling out possibility of any inference during investigation. Hence, the petitioners may be granted the privilege of anticipatory bail.

5. On the other hand, the learned Public Prosecutor opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Heard and perused the case record of the learned trial court summoned and received attached with the case diary. Para-04 is the re-statement of the informant supporting the occurrence. Para-5 is the description of place of occurrence . Para no. 6,7,8,9,10,29,30 of the case diary reflects the statement of witnesses supporting the

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occurrence, where some of the witnesses have stated that on account of previous enmity in between the parties the occurrence took place. The injury report of Shyama Devi reflects laceration on frontal region of head and pain over the body, simple in nature, caused by hard and blunt substance. The injury report of injured Arjun Ram reflects abrasion on right shoulder, simple in nature caused by hard and blunt substance. The injury report of injured Triful Devi reflects laceration on temporal region, simple in nature, caused by hard and blunt substance and the investigation has already been completed extending the benefit u/s 35(3) of the BNSS to the petitioners and there is nothing on record to suggest that he ever misused the privilege granted in their favour. Para-19 of the case diary reflects clean antecedent of accused petitioners.

7. Under the facts and circumstances of the present case, the nature of allegation, case and counter case in between the parties and the clean antecedent of the petitioners, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners stand allowed. Accordingly, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned court below within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order, let the petitioners namely **Subhash Ram, Amarjeet Ram, Rajesh Ram, Sandip Ram, Saroj Raj, Rajiya Devi, Asha Devi, Rahul Ram, Bimla Devi, Pradeep Ram, Badari Ram, Sakal Dip Ram, Ramchandra Ram, Ganauri Devi, Laxman Ram, Raju Ram, Shankar Ram and Arun Ram** be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.15,000/- (Fifteen thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the court of learned SDJM, Biraul subject to conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita.
