Order

23.07.2026 The present bail petition has been filed on behalf of the above-named petitioner, who is in judicial custody since 05.05.2026, in connection with Tilleshwar PS case No. 60 of 2026, for the offences U/Ss 126(2), 115(2), 140(3), 87, 352, 351(3), 3(5) of BNS, which is pending in the Court of Ms. Ankita, JMFC, Biraul, Darbhanga.

Heard Sri Ram Bilash Yadav the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner and Sri Bachcha Rai Ld. Counsel for State.

The FIR in the present case has been lodged on the basis of application of informant namely Rambinod Ray. The case of the prosecution in brief is that on 20.04.2026 at around 8 PM the accused persons namely Niranjan Kumar Ray alias Bullu Rai, Abhishekh Kumar, Sachin Ray entered informant's house forcibly carrying illegal weapons. Verbally abused informant and pointing guns to threaten informant and his family members, they forcibly grabbed his daughter Sonam Kumari. They dragged her towards the maize field and abducted her. Informant has fear that the accused may cause harm to his daughter. The application also mentions that the informant had submitted an application to the police station regarding continuous threats, deadly attacks and criminal activities by the accused.

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Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is quite innocent and he has not committed any offence. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in this false case. NO such occurrence did ever take place as alleged in the FIR. He submits that no offence u/s 87 BNS is made out against the petitioner. The petitioner is ready to abide by all the conditions as imposed by the Court. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 05.05.2026. Therefore the present petition may be allowed.

On the other hand, Ld. Addl. P.P appearing on behalf of the State opposed the prayer for bail.

Upon considering the rival submissions and on perusal of the materials available on record this court finds that statement of victim Sonam Kumari recorded u/s 183 BNSS is attached with the case records from perusal whereof it appears that the victim has stated before the Ld. Magistrate that on 20.04.2026 at around 7 PM the petitioner had taken her forcibly to maize field where he in connivance with Abhisekh Kumar forcibly took her away on a motorcycle to Saharsa. Considering the discussions made above, nature of allegation, statement of victim recorded u/s 183 of BNSS, gravity of the offence as well as other facts and circumstances of the case this Court does not feel inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Accordingly the prayer for bail of the above-named petitioner is hereby **rejected**.
