Order

24.07.2026 The present application for anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of abovenamed petitioners, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Biraul PS case No. 331 of 2025, for the offence punishable under sections 191(2), 191(3), 190, 115(2), 118(1), 117(2), 303(2), 74, 109, 352, 351(2) and 3(5) of BNS, which is pending in the Court of Ld. ACJM, Biraul, Darbhanga.

Heard Sri Ravi Shankar Mishra the Ld. Counsel for the petitioners and Sri Bachcha Rai Ld. Counsel for State.

The FIR in the present case has been lodged on the basis of application of informant namely Runa Devi. The case of the prosecution in brief is that on 07.09.2025 at around 11 PM the accused persons named in the FIR including these

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petitioners armed with weapons arrived at the house of informant and abused her. Upon objected by the informant Praveen Poddar ordered to make her naked and beat. Gautam Poddar and Krishan Poddar caught her hair and dragged her. They assaulted her with kicks. Praveen poddar assaulted her with rod on his head and arms. Krishan Poddar assaulted Ram Udgar Poddar with Khukhri on his head. Parveen Poddar and Naveen Kumar Poddar assaulted husband of informant with rod. Sudhir Poddar taken Rs. 26,000/- cash from informant's husband. Soni Devi snatched gold mangalsutra from neck of informant. Munni Devi, Seema Kumari and Raushni Kumar taken goods worth of Rs. 1,25,000/-. After that injured were taken to hospital.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioners are quite innocent and they have not committed any offence. The petitioners have falsely been implicated in this false case. No such occurrence did ever take place as alleged in the FIR. There is case and counter case between the parties. The petitioners are ready to abide by all the conditions as imposed by the Court. Therefore the present petition may be allowed.

On the other hand, Ld. Addl. P.P appearing on behalf of the State opposed the prayer for bail.

Upon considering the rival submissions and on perusal of the materials available on record this court finds that Para 8, 9 of the case diary mentions statement of witnesses who have supported the case. Para 68 of the case dairy mentions that petitioners are also accused of Biraul PS case No. 307/25. The injury reports of injured are mentioned in para 72, 73, 74, 75, 80, 81, 82 of case diary. Specific allegation of assault has been alleged against these petitioners. Considering the discussions made above, nature of allegation, injury received by the injured,

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criminal antecedents of the petitioners and the fact that investigation in this case is still going on and iota of evidence is yet to come as well as other facts and circumstances of the case this court does not feel inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Accordingly the prayer for anticipatory bail of the above-named petitioners is hereby **rejected**.
