ORDER

10-06-2026 Application for regular bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely Ashish Kunwar @ Natawar Kunwa, who is in judicial custody since 22.05.2026 in connection with Ghanshyampur P.S. Case No. 230/2022 for the offences 341, 342, 323, 308, 504/34 IPC, pressed today.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Public Prosecutor on behalf of the State.

3. The allegation is that on the alleged date of occurrence of 22.08.2022 at 7:00 pm the informant was coming from Bhagwati Asthan and reached near the house of ShivShankar poddar then accused Rahul Ray, Rajesh Kunwar, Rahul Kunwar, Hari Om Chaudhary, Saurabh Jha, Praveen Kunwar, Amrendra Kunwar, Dipak Kunwar, Virchandra Kunwar, Ashish Kunwar, Natwar Kunwar along with 6-7 others surrounded the informant and started abusing and assaulting him with fists, slaps and danda. It is alleged that accused Saurabh Jha gave knife blow upon the head of the informant. It is further alleged that accused Rahul Ray gave knife blow, which hit on his hand and other accused persons assaulted him with lathi, danda. In the meantime, accused Rahul Kunwar took out Oppo Mobile and cash of Rs. 1300/- from the pocket of the informant. It is further alleged that accused Ashish Kunwar and Natwar Kunwar took away golden chain and titan wrist watch, resulting into the institution of the present case.

4. It has been submitted that the accused-petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in this case. He further submitted that they have never been implicated in this case due to grudge, enmity and dirty village politics. The entire prosecution story as alleged by the informant is false, baseless and fabricated one. It is further submitted that all the offences are bailable except the offence under Section 308 of the IPC which is not attracted against the accused

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petitioners as the injured has found only simple injury over his person. It is, therefore, prayed to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail.

5. On the other hand, the learned Public Prosecutor opposes the prayer of regular bail.

6. From perusal of record, it is alleged that accused petitioners that they abused and assaulted to the informant with fists, slaps, lathi, danda and knife and committed theft. The doctor has found abrasion on scalp, abrasion above left eye, abrasion in right hand and abrasion on back in right side, which corroborate the allegation levelled against the accused petitioners. After investigation I.O of this case has found the case to be true and submitted charge-sheet against the accused petitioners. It is mentioned in para-3 of the bail application that accused petitioner have ^{note}criminal antecedent and the Investigating Officer did not opt to arrest the present accused petitioners and the learned Court below after taking of cognizance, but the petitioner could not appear in the learned Court below and hence he was judicially remanded and is in custody since 22.05.2026.

7. Under the facts and circumstances of the present case, the nature of allegation , where the injuries found on the person of injured are superficial in nature coupled with the period of custody of the petitioner and is clean antecedent, the prayer for regular bail of the petitioner stands **allowed**. Let the petitioner namely Ashish Kunwar @ Natawar Kunwar , be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.15,000/- (Fifteen thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Court of learned S.D.J.M, Biraul.
