Order

28.07.2026 The present application for anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of the above-named petitioners, who are apprehending their arrest, in conneciton with Biraul PS case No. 466 of 2025, for the offences punishable under sections 191(2), 329(3), 126(2), 115(2), 109, 117(1), 191(3), 351(2) of BNS, which is pending in the Court of ACJM, Biraul, Darbhanga.

Heard Sri Sudhir Kumar Mishra the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner and Sri Bachcha Rai Ld. APP for State.

The FIR in the present case has been lodged on the basis of application of informant namely Ganga Sahu. The case of the prosecution in brief is that on 07.11.2025 at around 3.30 PM the accused persons as named in the FIR including petitioners armed with lathi, danda, iron rod, bricks came and

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started abusing and beating informant. When wife and daughter of informant namely Punam Devi and Gudiya Kumari came to rescue him then they have also assaulted them. Sulinder Sahu assaulted informant with iron Khanti. Sanjay Sahu assaulted wife of informant with iron rod on her head. Kiran Devi assaulted informant's daughter with bricks on her head. After that the injured were taken to Hospital.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioners are quite innocent and they have not committed any offence. All the alleged offences are bailable save and except offence u/s 109 of BNS which is not attracting against the petitioners. He further submits that both the parties have amicably settled their disputes and a compromise petition has also been filed with this petition. He further submits that co-accused persons namely Kiran Devi, Lakshmi Kumari and Lukhiya Devi have already been granted anticipatory bail by this Court's order dt. 15.04.2026 passed in ABP No. 1820 of 2025;Reg No. 19 of 2026. The petitioners are law abiding citizens and they are ready to abide by all the conditions as imposed by the court. Therefore the present petition may be allowed.

On the other hand, Ld. Addl. P.P appearing on behalf of the State though opposed the prayer for bail but admitted the factum of compromise.

Upon considering the rival submissions and on perusal of the materials available on record this court finds that the both the parties have amicably settled their dispute and the informant/victim has no objection if the bail petition of petitioners is allowed. Further para 03 of the bail petition of petitioners mentions that they have no criminal antecedents. Co-accused Kiran Devi, Lakshmi Kumari and Lukhiya Devi have already been granted

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anticipatory bail by this Court's order dt. 15.04.2026 passed in ABP No. 1820 of 2025(Reg No. 19 of 2026). Considering the discussions made above, submissions made at bar as well as other facts and circumstances of the case the prayer for anticipatory bail of the above-named petitioners is **allowed**. The petitioners are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each in the event of their arrest by police or surrender before Ld. Court below in connection with Biraul PS case No. 466/25 to the satisfaction of learned Court below subject to condition laid down u/s 482(2) of BNSS.
