ORDER

26.03.2026 The present anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioners namely 1.Badari Mukhiya, 2.Sita Ram Mukhiya, 3.Tetari Devi in connection with Ghanshyampur P.S. Case No- 118/25, for offence u/s 80, 3(5) of BNS which is pending in the Court of Ld. ACJM-I,Biraul, Darbhanga.

Heard Sri Rambilash Yadav the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner and Sri Bachcha Rai, Ld. A.P.P. on behalf of the State.

The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not committed any offence and they are quite innocent. The petitioners have falsely been implicated in this false case. That in this bail application in all three accused persons in which pending for case diary. That there is no apprehension against the petitioner at this stage because I.O of this case non sent-up against the petitioner. That in the interest of justice it is necessary to permit the petitioner to withdraw the bail petition and also dismissed the said ABP, for that this petitioners shall ever pray.

On the other hand Ld. APP appearing for the State opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Heard, Submissions of both parties and perused the record and considering the discussion made above, a withdraw petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner to withdraw his ABP, it has been admitted by the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner that during the course of Said ABP the petitioners have been not sent-up by I.O. So in the interest of justice and the fact as well as other facts and circumstances of the case the present anticipatory bail petition of the petitioners namely 1.Badari Mukhiya, 2.Sita Ram Mukhiya, 3.Tetari Devi, ABP, is here by **dismissed** as withdrawn. In connection with Ghanshyampur P.S. Case No- 118/25 .
