**ORDER**

- 10-06-2026:** Application for anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioners namely **Ajan Devi, Anku Kumari @ Ankur Devi** who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Biraul PS Case No. 385 of 2023 for the offences U/Ss. 341, 323, 354 (A), 307, 504, 506/34 of the IPC, pressed today.
2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Public Prosecutor for the State.
3. The allegation is that on the alleged date of occurrence of 30.07 2023 while the informant was getting some work done at his land, meanwhile, Accused Kashi Chaupal, Shashi Chaupal, Anand Chaupal, Ajan Devi, Heena Devi, Ankur Devi all armed with iron rod, hammer, lathi came and Kashi Chaupal assaulted at the head of the informant's husband by hammer causing injury oozing out of blood and when the informant and her son Manoj her daughter-in-law Kiran Devi, the wife of Sanjay Chaupal, Bachan Devi and Geeta Devi came to rescue meanwhile, Shashi Chaupal assaulted the informant on head by iron rod causing injury, Anand Chaupal also assaulted by lathi on the person of Manoj Chaupal causing injury on head and accused Anand Chaupal torn down the blouse of the daughter-in-law of the informant with intention to outrage her modesty and Ajan Devi, Heena Devi, Ankur Devi all assaulted others by lathi and the injured were taken to Biraul hospital from where they were referred to Darbhanga Medical College and Hospital for treatment, resulting into the institution of the present case.
4. It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that the petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence and have falsely been implicated in the present case . It has further been submitted that by perusal of the First Information Report, it appears admitted that there is no specific allegation of assault has been alleged against the petitioners rather, it is general and omnibus in nature. The further submission is that during investigation, the police did not find the complicity of the present petitioners in

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the occurrence and hence exonerated them from the charge-sheet and they were not sent up, but, after submission of the police report, the learned Court below differing with the conclusion arrived by the police, took cognizance of the offence under Section 307 of the Indian Penal Code and the petitioners were also included in the cognizance order. The further submission is that the petitioners are ladies and they have got clean antecedent. Hence, they may be granted the privilege of anticipatory bail.

5. On the other hand, the learned Public Prosecutor opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Heard and perused the case record of the learned Court below summoned and received attached with the case diary. Para no. 6 of the case diary reflects description of place of occurrence. Para No. 7 and 8 of the case diary reflects the statement of witnesses supporting the occurrence. Para no. 19 is the injury report of Bipin Chaupal where swelling and lacerated wound on over left eyebrow and left little finger has been reported. Para no. 53 is the re-statement of the informant supporting the occurrence, the injury report of Kiran Devi reflects no external injury and after investigation, the police did not find the complicity of present petitioners to be true and did not sent up them for trial and Para no. 3 of the bail application reflects clean antecedent of the petitioners who are none other else but the ladies.

7. Under the facts and circumstances of the present case, the Court is of the opinion to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners stands **allowed**. Accordingly, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned court below within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order, let the petitioners namely 1..Ajan Devi, 2. Anku Kumari @ **Ankur Devi** be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.15,000/- (Fifteen thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate Biraul, Darbhanga subject to conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita.
