ORDER

18.04.2026

Anticipatory Bail petition is pressed today by the Ld. Chandraloki Kumar Mishra on behalf of the above named accused/petitioners apprehending arrest in connection with Kotwa P.S. Case No. 33/2026 u/s 126(2), 115(2), 109, 303(2), 76, 191(2), 352, 351(2) and 3(5) of B.N.S. Copy of the petition has already been served to learned A.P.P.

Informant and the injured persons have appeared before the court and filed their attendance and stated that the matter has been compromised.

Ld. Counsel appearing on behalf of the accused/petitioners submit that no other bail petition either anticipatory or regular has ever been filed earlier either in this Ld. Court or before any other higher Court on behalf of the petitioners. The petitioners have no criminal antecedent. Petitioners are quite innocent and have very falsely implicated in this case malafidely. This case is already compromised between both the parties and certified

copy of compromised with permission petition also annexed with this bail petition. It is therefore prayed that the court may pleased to admit this bail petition and petitioners shall ever pray.

The prosecution case in brief is that on 20.01.2026, informant's husband cut the wild vines and laid out on the road for dry and on the time of occurrence Chuman Singh and Robin Singh are travelled on that road and after seeing her husband both are started abusing and when her husband stop why you both are started abusing when I return your word in same, and after hearing of this word the both persons called their family members. They all come with lathi and gaddasi and they all physically assaulted the husband of the informant on back, stomach and leg in which he sustained greivous injuries. When she know about the incident, informant and her bhagina namely Gautam Kumar came to save her husband. At that time Chuman Singh attacked with gaddasi on Gautam Kumar's head with intention to kill him causing cut on his head and blood is oozing from his head. Other persons also assaulted them with lathi and dhanda. Robin Singh said that she should be stripped and paraded naked in the village. Following this, Satyam Singh, Vipul Singh, Chandeshwar Singh and Pratima Singh started beating her with sticks, causing injuries. Meanwhile the other accused persons tore her saree and blouse, dragged her while she was naked, and she was also injured and publicly humiliated. At that time of incident Babita Devi snatched Mangalsutra worth rs 50,000/- and Puja Devi snatched earrings worth Rs. 30,000/-. After the incident villagers took them to Sadar Hospital, Motihari.

Ld. A.P.P. opposed the same.

Heard and perusal of the case record, it reflects that the accused persons are named accused in the present FIR and the allegation against the accused/petitioners is that petitioners come with lathi and gaddasi and they all physically assaulted the husband of the informant on back, stomach and leg in which he sustained greivous injuries. Petitioner namely Chuman Singh attacked with gaddasi on Gautam Kumar's head with intention to kill him causing cut on his head and blood is oozing from his head. All the accused persons assaulted the informant, her bhagina and husband has sustained the injury. Petitioner Babita Devi snatched Mangalsutra worth rs 50,000/- and Puja Devi snatched earrings worth Rs. 30,000/-. In Para-02 of the case diary, restatement of informant and in para 05, 06 and 07 of the case diary the statement of witnesses have supported the case of the prosecution. In para 20 of the case diary, the injury report of the injured Gautam Bharadwaj is mentioned in which he sustained lacerated wound on head middle side and back pain, fracture of the proximal phalanx of Lt. Index finger is seen. Thus, the nature of the injury is grievous in nature In para 21 of the case diary, the injury report of the informant Nilu Devi is mentioned in which the nature of

the injury is simple in nature. In para 22 of the case diary the injury report of the injured Mayank Kumar is mentioned in which the nature of the injury is simple in nature. In para-17 of the case diary, it is mentioned that petitioners have clean antecedent. The case has been compromised between both the parties and compromise petition is duly signed by both the parties.

Considering the above discussed facts and circumstance of the case, nature of allegation, materials available in the case diary and the case has been compromise and having clean antecedent petitioners namely Chuman Singh, Rajnish Kumar, Robin Singh, Chandeshwar Singh, Kameshwar Singh, Vipul Kumar, Satyam Singh, Anita Devi, Babita Devi, Partima Devi and Puja Devi. Hence, I am inclined to give privilege of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners namely Chuman Singh, Rajnish Kumar, Robin Singh, Chandeshwar Singh, Kameshwar Singh, Vipul Kumar, Satyam Singh, Anita Devi, Babita Devi, Partima Devi and Puja Devi. Accordingly, in the event of their arrest or surrender within three weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order before the learned court below, the petitioners/accused, namely, **1. Chuman Singh 2. Rajnish Kumar 3. Robin Singh, 4. Chandeshwar Singh 5. Kameshwar Singh 6. Vipul Kumar 7. Satyam Singh 8. Anita Devi 9. Babita Devi 10 Partima Devi and 11. Puja Devi** are directed to be released on anticipatory bail, on furnishing their bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount in the aforesaid case, subject to condition as laid down u/s 482(2) of B.N.S.S., 2023.

O/C is directed to send the copy of the order to the Ld. Trial court forthwith.
