**ORDER**

This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the above named petitioner, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Raghunathpur P.S. Case No. 92 of 2025 registered under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 303(2), 351(2), 3(5), 308(4) of B.N.S and added section 109 of B.N.S.

Heard, the Ld. counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner and Ld. P.P. on behalf of State/O.P.

The case of the prosecution in brief as stated by the informant is that on 18.04.2025 at about 10:00 AM a piece of land measuring 7 dhur, located in village Balganga, Raghunathpur police station, the other shareholders were also present. The shareholder in front of informant's land, Meena Devi had also gone with him to lay the foundation of the house on the plot. They stood there and started watching. Then Atma Yadav came with 20 to 25 people. They were armed with sharp weapons like rod, lathi, nalkatuwa, sharp knives. As soon as they arrived Atma Yadav ordered the people accompanying him to assault him and bury them on the ground here and loot all the belongings. On his instigation Kanhaiya Yadav, Munna Yadav, Madhav yadav, Himanshu Singh, Mamta Singh, Mukul Singh, Babul Chaudhary, Guddu Singh alias Binod Singh and 10 unknown persons assaulted the informant and his brother. Himanshu Singh and Mamta Singh assaulted them with lathi. Meanwhile Atma Yadav assaulted the informant with farsa on his head with intention to kill him due to which he sustained

head injury and blood started oozing out, he fell down on the ground and he became unconscious. He was treated at Sadar Hospital Motihari. His brother told him that Santosh Kumar, Vinay Tiwari, Ranja Kumar, Meena Devi etc. people went to rescue him the Mukul Singh, Himanshu Singh, Bablu Chaudhary, Mamta Singh, Munna Yadav, Madhav Yadav and others assaulted them with lathi, danda, bricks etc. Kanhaiya Yadav assaulted Vinay Kumar with knife on his head with intention to kill him but while trying to escape, the knife hit on his nose and he got a deep wound on his nose and blood started oozing out. During the occurrence Mamta Singh took out Rs. 10,000 from the pocket of informant. Himanshu Singh and Mamta Singh crushed informants motorcycle with bricks and stones which cause damage worth about Rs. 10,000/-. Himanshu Singh snatched gold chain from the neck of informant's brother worth Rs. 2,00,000/-. Thereafter accused persons fled away.

Ld. counsel appearing on behalf of accused petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent, has committed no offence and he has falsely been implicated in this case. No other regular or anticipatory bail petition has ever been filed on behalf of the petitioner either before this court or any superior court. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent. The allegation whatsoever levelled against the petitioners is false and concocted. Further it has been submitted that there is a case and counter case between both the parties. Petitioner is ready to abide all the terms and conditions imposed by the court.

On other hand, Ld. Public Prosecutor(I/C) appearing on behalf of State opposed the prayer for anticipatory and has submitted that there is sufficient material against the petitioner in the case diary.

Heard both the sided and perused the record. From perusal of record it appears that on the instigation of co-accused Aatma Yadav, petitioner along with 10 unknown persons assaulted the informant and his brother with intention to kill them due to which they sustained head injury and blood started oozing out. Informant fell down on the ground and he became unconscious. Injury report of informant Kamlesh Tiwari shows he sustained incised wound on upper part of head of size 1 ½" x ½' x muscle deep. Pain and swelling on left leg of size 2' x 1". NCCT report of head shows Hemorrhagic contusions seen in left parieto temporal lobes. Non displaced fracture in left parieto-temporal bone with underlying acute epidural hemorrhage of maximum thickness-9

mm. Fracture of right nasal bone. Soft tissue scalp swelling in bilateral parieto-occipital region. Nature of injury shows **grievous** on the basis of CT scan of brain. In para 3, 13, 14 of the case diary, the witnesses examined during the course of investigation have corroborated the version of F.I.R. The allegation brought against the petitioner is serious in nature. Earlier bail application of the co-accused persons have been rejected by this court. At this stage in my opinion it will not be proper to grant him the privilege of anticipatory bail.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, and nature and gravity of the offence alleged, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the above named accused petitioner and accordingly, this anticipatory bail petition is hereby **rejected**.
