This is an anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner, namely, **Bhushan Singh**, in connection with Sugauli P.S. Case No. 552 of 2025 for the offences u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

**In para-2 of the bail petition, it is mentioned that no other regular or anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner either in this court or before the Hon'ble Patna High Court. In para-3 of the bail petition, it is mentioned that the petitioner has no any criminal antecedent.**

The prosecution's story, in brief, is that as brought by the informant-Anita Devi in her written application filed before the S.H.O. of Sugauli P.S., is that on 20.10.2025 at around 09:30 pm, she alongwith her husband and children was at her house on the occasion of Diwali, in the meantime, Sumit Jha (co-accused) came there riding on his motorcycle very rashly and negligently and tried to dash her children, to which her husband, namely, Brij Kishor Sah protested, then Sumit Jha and Bhushan Singh (petitioner) alongwith 5-6 unknown persons assaulted him. On hearing scream, the informant reached there and saw that Sumit Jha inflicted knife blow on the neck of her husband and Bhushan Singh (petitioner) had caught him, as a result, the informant's husband sustained injury with oozing blood. Thereafter, the accused persons fled away from there. Villagers brought the informant's husband to P.H.C. Sugauli, from where he was referred to Motihari for better treatment.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in this case. All the allegation whatsoever levelled against the petitioner are out and out false and concocted.

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The learned Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of State and learned counsel appearing on behalf of the informant have opposed the prayer for bail.

Heard both sides and perused the record. From perusal of the record, it transpires that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R. and the allegation is that when the informant alongwith her husband and children was at her house on the occasion of Diwali, in the meantime, Sumit Jha (co-accused) came there riding on his motorcycle very rashly and negligently and tried to dash her children, to which her husband, namely, Brij Kishor Sah protested, then Sumit Jha and Bhushan Singh (petitioner) alongwith 5-6 unknown persons assaulted him. On hearing scream, the informant reached there and saw that Sumit Jha inflicted knife blow on the neck of her husband and Bhushan Singh (petitioner) had caught him, as a result, the informant's husband sustained injury with oozing blood. In para-25 of the case diary, Injury Report of Brij Kishor Sah (informant's husband) is mentioned, where he sustained sharp cut injury over back of his neck of size 6 x 1/2 x skin deep and nature of injury is grievous. In Para- 2, 5, 6, & 7 of the case diary, the informant in her restatement and the witnesses have corroborated the version of the F.I.R. and supported the prosecution case. As per para-3 of the anticipatory bail petition and para-22 of the case diary, the petitioner has no any criminal antecedent. The investigation is under progress.

In the facts of the case as discussed above and keeping in view nature of allegation, materials available in the case diary & injury report, I am not inclined to give the privilege of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of petitioner, namely, **Bhushan Singh** stands **rejected**.
