01. This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of (1) Khedan Sah, S/O- Late Khenar Sah, aged about 68 years & (2) Amrita Devi, W/O- Virendra Sah, aged about 31 years, Both are R/O- Bankatwa, P.S.- Paharpur, District- East Champaran in connection with Paharpur P.S. Case No. 594/2025 under sections 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118(1), 109, 303(2), 3(5) of the B.N.S.

02. The petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with the above-mentioned case on the allegations of assaulting the informant, taking away mobile, golden hanumani and cash of Rs. 20,000/- from the informant alongwith other co-accused.

03. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence as alleged and have falsely been implicated in this case. Further stated that no other regular or anticipatory bail petition has been filed by the accused petitioners either in this court or before the Hon'ble High Court. Further stated that the petitioners have got no criminal antecedents. Further stated that allegations, whatsoever, levelled against the petitioners are out and out false and concocted. Further stated that the petitioners emphatically denies the whole of allegations levelled in the F.I.R. Further stated that the F.I.R. has been lodged after delay of six days. Further stated that the accused side has also lodged Paharpur P.S. Case No. 595/25 against informant and others. Lastly it has been stated that the petitioners are ready to give sureties for the satisfaction of this court.

04. Learned Addl. Public Prosecutor opposed the prayer of bail and prayed for rejection of prayer of bail of petitioners.

05. Heard Ld. Counsel for the petitioners & Ld. A.P.P. for the state and perused the record.

06. From the perusal of record it shows that the injury suffered by the injured was simple in nature. Further from perusal of the record it shows that the petitioners have got no previous criminal antecedents. Again from the perusal of record it shows that the F.I.R. has been lodged after delay of six days. In these circumstances, this court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners herein.

07. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, it is directed that petitioners namely (1) Khedan Sah & (2) Amrita Devi on surrender before the court within four
