01. This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of (1) Brijesh Yadav, S/O- Rambabu Yadav, aged about 22 years (2) Rambabu Yadav, S/O- Late Mukhtar Ray, aged about 50 years (3) Amresh Yadav, S/O- Munna Yadav, aged about 27 years (4) Munna Yadav, S/O- Late Kamal Yadav, aged about 55 years (5) Ram Niwash Yadav, S/O- Rikhdeo Yadav, aged about 44 years & (6) Upendra Yadav, S/O- Awadhesh Yadav, aged about 29 years, All are R/O- Kalwari Majhariya, P.S.- Adapur, Distt- East Champaran in connection with Adapur P.S. Case No. 34/2026 under sections 115(2), 126(2), 118(1), 109, 303(2), 351(2), 352, 3(5) of the B.N.S. Name of the petitioner no. 1 namely Brijesh Yadav has already been deleted vide order dated 24.03.2026. Today, an affidavit has been filed regarding injured Chandan Patel stating therein that Sahil Babu Patel and Chandan Patel is the same person.

02. The petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with the above-mentioned case on the allegations of assaulting the son of the informant, taking away golden Hanumani from the neck of son of the informant and also taking away cash of Rs. 3800/ from the son of the informant alongwith other co-accused.

03. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence as alleged and have falsely been implicated in this case. Further stated that no other bail petition has been filed by the accused petitioners either in this court or before the Hon'ble High Court. Further stated that the petitioners have got no criminal antecedents. Further stated that there is no specific allegation against the petitioners. Further stated that the case has been compromised between the parties and the compromise petition is already on record. Lastly it has been stated that the petitioners are ready to give sureties for the satisfaction of this court.

04. Learned Addl. Public Prosecutor vehemently opposed the prayer of bail and

prayed for rejection of prayer of bail of petitioners.

05. Heard Ld. Counsel for the petitioners & Ld. A.P.P. for the state and perused the record.

06. The informant and injured are present before this court today and they have stated in the open court that they have amicably settled the dispute between the petitioners herein. The informant further stated that he has no objection in case the anticipatory bail is granted to them. Further from perusal of record it shows that the injury suffered by the injured was simple in nature. In these circumstances, this court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners no. 2 to 6.

07. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, it is directed that petitioners no. 2 to 6 namely Rambabu Yadav, Amresh Yadav, Munna Yadav, Ram Niwash Yadav & Upendra Yadav, on surrender before the court within four weeks from the date of order/ or at the time of arrest shall be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount, each subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 482 (2) of the B.N.S.S. to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below.
