This is a bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner, namely, **Ashish Singh**, who is in judicial custody since 16.02.2026 in connection with Chhatauni P.S. Case No. 87 of 2026 for the offences u/s 191(2), 329(2), 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109, 303(2), 74, 352, 351(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

**In para-2 of the bail petition, it is mentioned that no other regular or anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner either in this court or before the Hon'ble Patna High Court. In para-3 of the bail petition, it is mentioned that the petitioner has no any criminal antecedent. And in Para-4 of the bail petition, it is mentioned that the petitioner is in judicial custody 16.02.2026.**

As per F.I.R, Ashish Singh (petitioner) and other co-accused persons attacked the informant's son Sagar Subham. Ashish Singh (petitioner) attacked with the sharp part of Kudaal on the head of his son, causing him head injury. Ram Kishore Singh attacked him with an iron rod causing fracture in his right hand's finger. Anchal Devi snatched his golden chain worth Rs.1,00,000/- and cash worth Rs. 50,000/-. Sonu Kumari attacked the informant's son by an iron rod on his head. 10-15 unknown persons also attacked and Anchala Devi caused his husband Ratendra Kumar Srivastava serious internal injury. Accused persons also beat up the informant and stripped her naked and threw on the ground. The main reason for the dispute is that a 10 ft wide road is being constructed in the locality, and all these accused persons are not allowing it to be constructed by encroaching it unauthoroizedly, which her son was opposing.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has committed no offence. He has been falsely implicated in this case due to previous enmity, land dispute and with an intention to put pressure and to save skin a counter case vide Chhatauni P.S. Case No.88/2026 u/s 191(2), 329(2), 126(2), 115(2), 352, 351(2), 74, 303(2) of B.N.S. has been lodged by co-accused Anupama Kumari (sister of the petitioner) against the informant's son Sagar Shubham and his men.

The learned Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of State and learned counsel appearing on behalf of the informant have opposed the prayer for bail.

Heard both sides and perused the record. From perusal of the record, it transpires that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R. with the allegation of assault the informant's son with Kudaal, resulting in head injury due to previous land dispute. As per Para-02 of the case diary, the informant in her restatement has fully supported the version of the F.I.R. As per Para-9 & 10 of the case diary, the witnesses have fully corroborated the version of the F.I.R. As per Para-31 of the case diary containing NCCT Head-Report & Plate waited of Sagar Shubham, impression is given as Incised wound on occipital region of head of size 1 1/2"x 1/3" x skin deep and X-ray right hand-Report & Plate waited, of Sagar Shubham, impression is given as incised wound on right hand little finger of size 1/2" x 1/3" skin deep. At present, the investigation in this case is continuing. As per Para-03 of the bail petition and Para-28 of the case diary it is mentioned that the petitioner has no any criminal antecedent.

In the facts of the case as discussed above and keeping in view nature of allegation, materials available in the case diary & injury report, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the prayer for bail of petitioner, namely, **Ashish Singh** stands **rejected**.
