This bail petition is filed on behalf of the petitioner Subodh Kumar Singh, who is in judicial custody since 18.02.2026 in connection with Patahi P.S. Case No. 120 of 2023 u/ss 467, 468, 471, 420 and 120(B) of Indian Penal Code.

**As per para-2 of the bail petition, the petitioner's anticipatory bail petition vide A.B.P. No. 2054/2024 and Cr. Misc. No. 30478/2025 was rejected by this Court and by the Hon'ble Patna High Court, respectively except that no other regular or anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner either in this court or before any superior Court. As per para-3 of the bail petition the petitioner has no criminal antecedent and as per para-4 of the bail petition the petitioner is in judicial custody since 18.02.2026.**

As per F.I.R., Sri Gopal Krishn, Dy. Superintendent of Police, Surveillance Bureau, Patna has been deputed to verify the educational certificates of the employed teachers of District- East Champaran. During verification of records it was found that the teacher Subodh Kumar Singh (petitioner), appointed in 2008 under Panchayat Raj Ganhia (East Champaran), had submitted his Matriculation certificates bearing Roll No. 338, Roll Code 316, Year 1991, Marks 594 and Division- First at the time of his appointment. These documents were sent to Bihar Sanskrit Education Board, Patna for verification. As per Report No. 486, dated 07.11.2022 from the Examination Controller of Bihar Sanskrit Education Board, the abovesaid roll number and code correspond to another student's

name, not Subodh Kumar Singh (petitioner) and the submitted mark-sheet and certificate were not issued by the Board and the document were found to be fake/forged.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has committed no offence. The petitioner has submitted original document in counseling of teacher, but which has wrongly been asserted by surveillance investigation bureau. The detail of certificate and mark-sheet of Matric is fake and not issued by the board, it does not mean the petitioner has submitted forged document. The petitioner has submitted the paper issued by the board properly and without its verification surveillance investigation bureau has sent a letter for lodging the F.I.R. The petitioner has rightly submitted the document relating to his certificate.

The learned Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of State has opposed the prayer for bail.

Heard both sides and perused the record. From perusal of record, it transpires that the petitioner is named accused in the F.I.R. with the allegation that he had obtained job of teacher on the basis of his fake matriculation marks-sheet and certificate issued by Bihar Sanskrit Education Board, which was verified by the said board and certificate of the petitioner is found to be forged as roll number and code, mentioned in the mark-sheet, correspond to another student's name, not Subodh Kumar Singh (petitioner). As per para-3 of the case diary, the informant in his restatement has supported the prosecution case. As per para-3 of the bail petition and para- 103 of the case diary, the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. The petitioner deserved no leniency as the alleged crime affects entire educational system.

In the facts of the case as discussed above and keeping in view the nature of the allegation and materials available in the case diary, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner, namely, **Subodh Kumar Singh** stands **rejected**.
