ORDER

1. An application for grant of anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner namely Ankit Kumar who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Kalyanpur P.S. Case No. 37/2026. U/s- 331(4), 305(a) of B.N.S.
2. Heard the Ld. Counsel on behalf of the petitioner as well as Ld A.P.P. on behalf of the prosecution on the anticipatory bail petition under consideration.
3. As per the FIR, the prosecution case in brief, is that informant namely Ram Bharosh Ram, S/o Late Baliram. On 22.01.2026 at around 08:00 O'Clock he runs and closes his shop. During that time unknown thieves broken his shop's lock and stolen six sacks of rice, and others stationary itmes as well as 18,000/- rupees.
4. Ld. Counsel on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that no other regular or anticipatory bail petition has ever been filed in this Ld.Court or before hon'ble high court, patna. He further submits that the petitioner has no criminal history and the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He further submitted that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R and nor was arrested at the spot.
5. Ld. A.P.P. appearing on behalf of the state has vehemently opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner. Further Ld. A.P.P has submitted that as per para 15 of the case diary search and seizure memo is available and as per para 37 of the case diary there is no criminal antecedent is pending against petitioner.
6. Heard both side & perused the case record and as per submission made on behalf of both sides, it appears that petitioner is not named in F.I.R. On perusal of case diary it transpires that witnesses of the case diary have not specifically taken the name of the petitioner regarding alleged offence. Further from the perusal of para 15 of the case diary search and seizure memo is available and as per para 37 of the case diary it appears that there is no criminal antecedent is pending against the petitioner. Further from the perusal of entire case record it also appears that the comopromise petition

along with permission petition is available with this case record and after perusing of it also appears that the informant Ram Bharosa Ram has made compromised with accused/petitioner Ankit Kumar in presence of their family well-wishers and he has no any greivances against the accused/petitioner and he does not want to further proceed with this case.

7. Considering the above mentioned facts & circumstances petitioner namely **Ankit Kumar is directed to be released on anticipatory bail** in the event of his arrest or surrender within one month of the receipt of this order on furnishing bail bonds of rupees ten thousand with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld.Court Concerned subject to the condition laid down u/s 482 of the B.N.S.S. with further condition :-

- (i) Petitioner shall not repeat any such offence in future.
- (ii) Petitioner shall not induce, threat or promise to any witness acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case.
- (iii) Petitioner shall cooperate in investigation and trial.
