ORDER

This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the above named petitioners, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Adapur P.S. Case No. 71 of 2025, U/s- 115(2), 126(2), 109, 303(2), 76, 352, 351, 117(2) and 3(5) of B.N.S.

Heard, the Ld. counsel appearing on behalf of petitioners and Ld. P.P.(I/C) on behalf of State/O.P.

The case of the prosecution in brief as stated by the informant is that on 08.02.2025 at about 10 AM she was sitting at her door in the meantime all the F.I.R. named accused persons including these petitioners armed with lathi-danda, iron rod, farsa came there and started abusing her. When she protested, accused Binda Sahani instigated to other accused persons to assault her. On the instigation of accused Binda Sahani all the accused persons assaulted her. When her brother-in-law Rajkishore, her husband Rajdeo Prasad Chaudhary, her sister-in-law Nirmala Devi, Kameshwar Prasad, Basdeo Prasad were came to rescue her accused Saroj Sahani assaulted Rajkiore Prasad with farsa due to which he sustained injury on his hand and blood started oozing out. Amrendra Sahani assaulted Kameshwar Chaudhary with iron rod due to which he sustained injury on his hand and his hand got fractured. Patwari assaulted the informant's husband with farsa due to which he sustained injury on his waist. Accused Mukesh Sahani tore the clothes of informant's sister-in-law. Nishu Sahani snatched gold mangalsutra worth of Rs. 35,000/- from the neck of the informant. Vikesh Sahani and Kawal Sahani assaulted her with kick and fist. Accused Ajay Sahani and Rakesh Sahani snatched her gold ornaments from her nose, ear and from her neck. Nearby people came there and rescued them and took them to hospital for their treatment.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have not committed the offence. Petitioners have not preferred any regular or anticipatory bail petition before any superior Court. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent. Further it has been submitted that the allegations leveled against the petitioners are false and concocted. There is no specific allegation levelled against these petitioners. Petitioner is ready to abide all the terms and conditions imposed by the court.

On other hand, Ld. Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Heard both sides and perused the record. From perusal of record it appears that there is an omnibus allegation against the petitioners that he along with co-accused persons assaulted the informant. From perusal of record it also appears that there is no any specific allegation of assaulted was attributed against these petitioners. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, nature of the allegations brought against the petitioners, I am inclined to give privilege of pre-arrest bail to above named accused petitioners. Accordingly, in the event of their arrest or surrender in the trial court within four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order, before the learned trial court, the above named petitioners are ordered to be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each subject to the satisfaction of the learned trial court in the aforesaid case and subject to the condition as laid down u/s 482(2) of B.N.S.S. with further conditions that (i) One of the bailor shall be the close relative of the petitioners (ii) Petitioners shall physically appear each and every date before the court till framing of charges. (iii) Petitioners shall not involve himself in the similar nature of the offence in future.
