1. This bail petition has been filed on behalf of the aforesaid accused/petitioner, who is in custody since 17.03.2026 in connection with Ghorasahan P.S. Case No.449/2024 u/s 191(2), 191(3), 190, 115(2), 118(1), 172(2), 109(1), 352, 351(3) BNS.

Heard Ld Counsel for the petitioners and Ld. Public Prosecutors I/C on behalf of the state.

2. The prosecution's case in brief as per FIR lodged by the informant Phulshankar Devi, in respect of Ghorasahan PS, East Champaran, is that on is that on 25.11.2024 at 11:30 AM, when informant and her son namely Shubash Singh was at her door, at that time all the FIR named accused persons came there with weapon. On the saying of accused Dhurv Singh, accused Ankit Kumar assaulted with farsa to informant's son's head three times, which caused injury received and accused Dhurv Singh assaulted with rod, which caused broken hand and finger broke. When informant went to save there then they pushed down her. When her son-in-law namely Rahul Kumar came to save then accused Deepak Kumar assaulted with rod to his head and repeated blow, which caused injury received. All the accused persons assaulted with them. After that they went to hospital for treatment.

3. Learned Counsel for the petitioner submitted that No other regular bail petition has ever been filed in this learned court or before the Hon'ble High court, Patna, except

an ABP was rejected vide ABP no 199/25 and Cr. Misc. No. 28487/25 was rejected by the Hon'ble Court. The petitioner has no criminal history. The petitioner has been rotting in jail custody since 17.03.2026. The petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence as alleged and has very falsely been implicated in this case due to malafide intention. It is further submitted that the petitioner deserves mercy to be enlarged on bail and ready to give sureties as may be ordered. Accordingly, Ld. Counsel prayed to release the petitioner.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor I/C opposed the prayer for bail.

5. Heard both sides and perused the record. On perusal, I find that petitioner is named in the FIR for the offences u/s 191(2), 191(3), 190, 115(2), 118(1), 172(2), 109(1), 352, 351(3) BNS. The allegation against the petitioner is that he assaulted with rod to informant's grandson namely Rahul Kumar. Injury of Rahul Kumar is a cut mark on right eyebrow which is simple in nature caused by hard and blunt object, which is mentioned in CD 28. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent which is mentioned in CD para 50. Petitioner is in custody since 17.03.2026.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousands) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court concerned, Motihari, East Champaran.
