1. The accused/ petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail order arising out of Patahi P.S. Case No.- 468/25, u/s 126(2)/115(2)/118(1)/109(1)/352/351(2)/3(5) of the BNS.

2. The prosecution case as per written application of the informant Santoshi Devi given to the SHO of Patahi PS stating therein that at 08.00 PM petitioner and FIR named accused persons and some unknow persons came at her door and assaulted her entire family with lathi and attempted to kill her husband who flew away but sustained serious head injuries and was first treatment at PHC Patahi and later referred to Sadar Hospital Motihari where his condition remains critical and further abused and threatened her daughter Bharti.

3. Learned Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence as alleged against him. No other regular or anticipatory bail petition has ever been filed earlier either in this court or before the any Higher court. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedents. Accordingly, Ld. Counsel prayed to enlarge on bail in the event of his arrest or surrender.

4. Learned Addl. Public Prosecutor opposed the prayer for bail.

5. Heard both sides and perused the record. On perusal, I find that petitioner is named in the FIR for the offences u/s 126(2)/115(2)/118(1)/109(1)/352/351(2)/3(5) of the BNS. As per FIR the allegation against of the petitioner is that he assaulted the informant's husband causing injuries on his head. The petitioner has no criminal antecedents.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances and discussion made herein above, this court is of the view that the petitioner has made out a case for grant of anticipatory bail order in his favour. Accordingly, the prayer of petitioner is hereby allowed and the petitioner in the event of his arrest or surrender before the concerned court be released/admitted on bail subject to furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court of learned lower court, Motihari, East Champaran.
