This bail petition is filed on behalf of the petitioners-accused, namely, (1) Ramjee Mahto and (2) Amarjeet Sah, who are in custody since 17-11-2025 and 24-10-2025 respectively in connection with Patahi P.S. Case No.122 of 2025 u/s 317(2), 3017(5) and 3(5) of the B.N.S.

The prosecution case, in brief, is that on secret information the police conducted raid at the house of accused Govind Sah and recovered a stolen motorcycle. Upon query, he disclosed that he along with his brother Amarjeet Sah (petitioner) has stolen the said motorcycle from Chhatauni. Thereafter, the police conducted raid at the house of petitioner Ramjeet Mahto and also recovered a stolen motorcycle.

In para-2 of the bail petition, it is mentioned that earlier ABP No.1857 of 2025 was filed by the petitioner No.1, which was disposed of and B.P. No.3310 of 2025 and 3147 of 2025 were filed on behalf of petitioners, which was rejected by the learned Court of 20th Addl. Sessions Judge, Motihari with an observation that petitioners may renew their prayer for bail after framing of charge. In para-3 of the bail petitions, it is mentioned that petitioners have no criminal antecedent and in para-4, it is mentioned that petitioner No.1 is in custody since 17-11-2025 and petitioner No.2 is in custody since 24-10-2025.

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The learned counsel for the petitioners-accused has submitted that the petitioners-accused are innocent and they have committed no offence and have falsely been implicated in this case. It is further submitted no any incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious possession of petitioners. Charge has been framed against the petitioners on 12-03-2026.

The learned Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of State has opposed the prayer for bail on the basis of materials available on record.

Heard both sides and perused certified copy of F.I.R. as well as documents available on record. As per F.I.R., stolen motorcycle has been recovered from the house of petitioners. It transpires that the prayer for bail of petitioners has been rejected by the Court of learned 20th Addl. Sessions Judge, Motihari vide B.P. No.3310 of 2025 and 3147 of 2025 with an observation that petitioners may renew their prayer for bail after framing of charge. Now, charge has been framed against the petitioners on 12-03-2026. As per para-3 of the bail petition, the petitioners have no criminal antecedent. The petitioner No.1 and 2 are in custody since 17-11-2025 and 24-10-2025 respectively.

Considering all these facts, as discussed above and keeping in view the observation passed in B.P. No.3310 of 2025 and 3147 of 2025 and period of detention, this bail petition is allowed. Accordingly, the petitioners-accused, namely, **Ramjee Mahto and Amarjeet Sah** are ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below in the aforesaid case.
