ORDER

This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the above named petitioner, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Chhatauni P.S. Case No. 77 of 2024, U/s- 379, 414, 413 read with 34 of I.P.C.

Heard, the Ld. counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner and Ld. P.P. on behalf of State/O.P.

The case of the prosecution as brought by the informant S.I. Jahid Akhtar in his written application in brief is that on 09.02.2024, while on evening patrolling duty when he along with other police personnel reached near Dev Dharm Kata, a woman near Chandi Mai Sthan shouted that some miscreants were running away after snatching her mobile phone out of which one miscreant was apprehended; the rest managed to escape. The apprehended miscreant disclosed his name as Arhaan Khan. Upon searching him, a silver and black Apple mobile phone was recovered from his right pocket. He also disclosed the name of his companions who were manged to flee away as Rahul Kumar, Naushad Ansari, Vishnu Kumar, and Arif Ansari. He also stated that he used to snatch mobile phones from passersby to make ends meet. Meanwhile, he and his companions were trying to snatch a mobile phone from the woman and he was caught by the police. Thereafter he was arrested by the police.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that petitioner is quite innocent and has not committed the offence. Petitioner has not preferred any regular or anticipatory bail petition before any superior Court. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent. Further it has been submitted that the allegations leveled against the petitioners are false and concocted. Petitioner was not arrested at the spot by the police and his name was was disclosed by the apprehended accused Arhaan Khan. Petitioner has no concern with the apprehended accused. No incriminating article has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. Petitioner is ready to abide all the terms and conditions imposed by the court.

On other hand, Ld. Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Heard both sides and perused the record. From perusal of record and case diary it appears that the allegation against the petitioner that he along with other co-accused persons were trying to snatch the mobile phone of one woman near Chandi Mai Asthan and co-accused Arhaan Khan was apprehended by the police and he disclosed the name of the petitioner and other co-accused persons as his associates. No incriminating article has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner nor he was arrested by the police at the spot. Moreover petitioner has no criminal antecedent and earlier co-accused persons have been granted bail by learned Principal District & Sessions Judge, Motihari.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, nature of the allegations brought against the petitioner, I am inclined to give privilege of pre-arrest bail to above named accused petitioner. Accordingly, in the event of his arrest or surrender in the trial court within four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order, before the learned trial court, the above named petitioner is ordered to be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each subject to the satisfaction of the learned trial court in the aforesaid case and subject to the condition as laid down u/s 482(2) of B.N.S.S. with further condition that:-

- (i) One of the bailor shall be the close relative of the petitioner.
- (ii) The petitioner shall physically appear each and every date before the court till framing of charge.
- (iii). Petitioner shall not involve himself in the similar nature of the offence in future and shall cooperate in trial.
