ORDER

19-06-26

1. Vide this order, regular bail application bearing No. 1415/26 filed on dated 14-05-26 on behalf of applicant/accused namely **Raju Kumar**, who is in Judicial custody in connection with the above mentioned case since 15-12-2025 is being disposed off.

2. Briefly stated prosecution story in nutshell is that on 05-12-2025 around 7:00 pm, the informant was going to his rented house from railway station and as soon as he reached near Power house chowk, three miscreants on a motorcycle appeared there and snatching his mobile, fled away. Further, on 07-12-2025, the informant found that Rs. 59,008/- has been withdrawn from his bank account through UPI and his G-mail has also been hacked.

3. In nutshell, it is argued on behalf of petitioner that no other regular or anticipatory bail petition has ever been filed either before this court or the Hon'ble court and having no criminal history, is quite innocent, has committed no offence as alleged, falsely been implicated in this case and is in custody since 15.12.2025. It is argued that the petitioner is not

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named in the FIR nor was arrested at the spot and nothing incriminating article has been recovered from his person and possession. The name of the petitioner has come on the confessional statement of the co-accused Manjan Kumar which has got no evidenciary value and prayer has been made to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

4. On the other hand, Learned Addl. P.P. for state very vehemently opposed the prayer of defence, however, no substantial arguments were made.

5. I have heard all the sides and gone through the record.

6. At this stage, it may be noted that the charge-sheet has been submitted in this case, petitioner has no criminal history, his name has been surfaced on the confessional statement of one Manjay Kumar who has already been granted bail. Accused is custody since 15.12.2025 and no purpose would be served to keep him behind the bar furthermore.

7. Under these facts & circumstances of the case and taking into account of period of custody, the accused/petitioner namely, **Raju Kumar** is directed to be released on bail after furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the learned Court below subject to condition that one of the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner.

8. Let, this order be sent to the concern court as well as also be uploaded on the court website immediately and file be consigned to the record room after due return of documents/materials submitted; if any; to the parties as per provisions.
