ORDER

This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the above named petitioners, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Pipra P.S Case No. 105 of 2026, U/s- 126(2), 115(2), 103(1), 3(5) of B.N.S.

Heard, the Ld. counsel appearing on behalf of petitioners and Ld. P.P. on behalf of State/O.P.

The case of the prosecution in brief as stated by the informant in his written report submitted before the police is that on 09.03.2026 at about 8:30 to 09:00 PM all the F.I.R. named accused persons including these petitioners and 5-6 unknown persons with a conspiracy found his grandson Ashish Kumar alone in the house and murdered him and they hanged him from the fan whose informant was given by the villagers to him. Then he came back home. Meanwhile the villagers took the dead body and took it to Chakia Hospital for treatment, where the doctor declared Ashish Kumar dead after examining him. On information the police came and took the dead body for post-mortem at Sadar Hospital Motihari. The reason for the incident is that all the accused persons have an evil eye on his land and property and want to grab it somehow because he has four daughters and no son, due to which he has kept his grandson at his home to take care of his property. Earlier also they assaulted his grandson.

Ld. counsel appearing on behalf of accused petitioners have submitted that petitioners are innocent and have not committed any offence and they have falsely been

implicated in this case. No other regular or anticipatory bail petition has ever been filed on behalf of the petitioners either before this court or any superior court. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent. The allegations whatsoever levelled against the petitioners is false and concocted. Further it has been submitted that petitioners have not been involved in such type of occurrence and petitioners have no concerned with the deceased. Petitioners are ready to abide all the terms and conditions imposed by the court.

On other hand, Ld. Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Heard both sides and perused the record. From the perusal of record it appears that the allegation against the petitioners that they along with co-accused persons committed murder of deceased. Death inquest report was mentioned in para 3 of the case diary. The witnesses examined during the course of investigation have corroborated the case of prosecution. Post-mortem report of deceased is annexed with the case diary as mentioned in para 54 of case diary, where cause of death is mentioned as Asphyxia due to hanging. The allegation against the petitioners is serious in nature. Investigation is still pending in this case. At this stage in my opinion it will not be proper to grant them the privilege of anticipatory bail.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, and nature and gravity of the offence and materials available in the case diary and also as per the post-mortem report, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the above named accused petitioners and accordingly, this anticipatory bail petition is hereby **rejected**.
