Accused on bail with Counsel Sh. Jagjit Singh Sahni Advocate.

No defence evidence is to be produced. In view of provisions of Section 437-A Cr.P.C., accused Ravinder Singh is directed to furnish personal bonds in the sum of Rs.20,000/- with one surety in the like amount.

Personal bond has been furnished by the accused, which has been accepted and attested. Accused has sought time to furnish surety bond, which is allowed.

Accused closed his defence evidence, vide separate statement.

Arguments heard. Vide my separate detailed judgment of even date, accused has been acquitted, as per detailed enumerated therein. His earlier bail bonds and surety bonds stand discharged. Case property, if any, be disposed of under rules, after expiry of period of appeal/revision, if any.

Accused is directed to furnish surety bonds in the sum of Rs.20,000/- under Section 437-A IPC within seven days from today. After compliance, file be consigned to the Judicial Record Room, Mohali, after due indexation.
