A regular bail petition on behalf of petitioner who is in judicial custody since 11.05.2026 in connection with Turkauliya P.S. Case No. 230/26, u/s- 303(2) of BNS. has been pressed today for hearing. Copy of petition already served to learned P.P. for state.

Heard Dr. Ajay Prasad learned lawyer appearing on behalf of the petitioner and Sri Khooblal Prasad learned P.P. for the state and perused the case record.

According to the FIR, the prosecution case in brief is that the iformant, Bhuali Prasad Yadav, stated that on 25.04.2026 at about 03:00AM., when he woke up, he found that his motorcycle was missing. He had parked his motorcycle at his door, but when he looked for it, the bike was not there. The motorcycle is a Hero Splendor bearing reg. no.BR05AP2055. He made extensive efforts to search for the motorcycle, but it could not be found.

The ld. counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner have submitted that as per para-2 of the bail petition, no other anticipatory or regular bail petition has ever been filed earlier either in this learned court or before Hon'ble High Court, Patna on behalf of the petitioner except this one. It has further submitted in para-3 of the bail petition that petitioner has one criminal antecedent i.e. Turkauliya PS case no. 219/26, except this petitioner has no any criminal antecedent and for this an affidavit

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
