Present case pertains to 29-04-2013, charge in which was framed on 31-08-2017 and since then prosecution availed ample effective opportunities in more than seven years, but failed to conclude its entire evidence despite last opportunity granted to them. In view of the law and guide lines laid down by **Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in 1999(4) RCR(Criminal)206 in case title as Raj Deo Sharma Vs State of Bihar**, court finder no justification to adjourn the present case for further evidence of the prosecution keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and accordingly, evidence of prosecution stands closed by order of the court. Now to come upon 23-02-2018 for recording the statement of U/S 313 CRPC.
