**Beldar Rai Vs. State of Bihar**

01. This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of Beldar Rai, S/O- Late Chandra Rai, aged about 43 years, R/O- Barharwa, P.S.- Muffasil, District- East Champaran in connection with Muffasil P.S. Case No. 73/2026 under sections 103(1), 61(2), 3(5) of the B.N.S.

02. The petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with the above-mentioned case on the allegations of committing murder of husband of the informant.

03. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence as alleged and has falsely been implicated in this case. Further stated that no other regular or anticipatory bail petition has been filed by the accused petitioner either in this court or before the Hon'ble High Court except ABP No. 1574/2026 which was dismissed in default. Further stated that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. Further stated that allegations, whatsoever, levelled against the petitioner are out and out false and concocted. Further stated that nothing incriminating article has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. Further stated that from perusal of F.I.R. it is also clear that after completing Dah Sanskar of the dead body to be understand natural death of deceased the F.I.R. thereafter mere in suspicion has been lodged against the petitioner and others. Lastly it has been stated that the petitioner is ready to give sureties for the satisfaction of this court.

04. Learned Addl. Public Prosecutor opposed the prayer of bail and prayed for rejection of prayer of bail of petitioner.

05. Heard Ld. Counsel for the petitioner & Ld. A.P.P. for the state and persued the record.

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06. From perusal of the record, it appears that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R. The allegations against the petitioner are extremely serious in nature and hence can not be easily countananced. In these circumstances, this court is not inclined to enlarge the anticipatory bail to the petitioner herein.

07. Considering above facts and circumstances and the seriousness of allegation, the anticipatory bail application moved by the petitioner namely Beldar Rai is hereby rejected.
