ORDER

- 22.06.2026** 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned P.P. appearing on behalf of the prosecution.
2. The above named petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with Paharpur P.S. Case No. 564 of 2025 for the offence punishable under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 117(2), 109, 76, 303(2), 352, 3(5) B.N.S.
3. The case of prosecution in brief is that the informant Sarita Kuwar alleged that on 21.10.2025 at 07.00 PM, the neighbor of the informant came to her house to call the son-in-law of the informant. The neighbor namely Mahendra Paswan was in drunk state. The informant opposed his son-in-law not to go with her neighbor, on this matter, all FIR named accused persons including this petitioner started abusing her and assaulted her. When the nephew of the informant namely Manu Paswan came to rescue then accused Mahendra Paswan gave farsa blow on the head of him. It is also alleged that when Ranjeet Paswan came to rescue them then accused Byas Paswan gave lathi blow on the head. The accused persons namely Mahesh Paswan, Suraj Paswan, Bharat Paswan, Dinanath Paswan also assaulted the brothers-in-law of the informant namely Arjun Paswan and Mishri Paswan. Accordingly the FIR has been lodged and the injured persons are admitted to the hospital.
4. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that no other regular or anticipatory bail petition has ever been filed earlier either before this Court or before the Hon'ble High Court except ABP No. 6026/25 which was rejected by the Id. Court of

2nd DAJ, Motihari and a Cri. Misc. No. 13061/26 was rejected by the Hon'ble High Court, Patna.

5. On the other hand, ld. P P opposed the prayer of the bail of the petitioner.

6. From perusal of the case diary, the petitioners are in judicial custody since 15.05.2026 and no criminal antecedents against the petitioner. I.O submitted five injury reports in this case. one injury of injured Mishri Paswan is grievous in nature, the injury is on his finger, not on the vital part of the body. All others injuries of injured persons are simple in nature. Co-accused persons granted bail in this case.

7. Under the facts and circumstances of the case, the accused/petitioner namely **Mahesh Paswan** is directed to be **released** on bail after furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the learned court below with condition that the petitioner will file an undertaking stating therein he will remain physically present in the court on each and every date till framing of charge.
