This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of Dipak Sahani @ Dipak Kumar, S/O- Suresh Sahani, aged about 30 years, R/O- Koral, P.S.- Pakaridayal, District- East Champaran in connection with Pakaridayal P.S. Case No. 210/2024 under sections 191(2), 191(3), 190, 126(2), 352, 351(2), 351(3), 115(2) of the B.N.S. & 25(1-B) (a), 26 of the Arms Act.
02. The petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with the above-mentioned case on the allegations of abusing and threatening the informant and also showing pistol in the air alongwith other co-accused.
03. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence as alleged and has falsely been implicated in this case. Further stated that no other regular or anticipatory bail petition has been filed by the accused petitioner either in this court or before the Hon'ble High Court except ABP No. 4874/24 which was disposed of. Further stated that the petitioner has got five criminal antecedent. Further stated that the petitioner has got no concern with the alleged occurrence. Further stated that there is no specific allegation against the petitioner as per the F.I.R. Lastly it has been stated that the petitioner is ready to give sureties for the satisfaction of this court.
04. Learned Addl. Public Prosecutor opposed the prayer of bail and prayed for rejection of prayer of bail of petitioner.
05. Heard both the sides and perused the record.
06. From the perusal of record it shows that earlier the anticipatory bail petition of this petitioner had already been disposed of by the Ld. Principal District & Sessions Judge, Motihari on 27.11.2024 and there is no further change of circumstances/ground for consideration of anticipatory bail of this petitioner afresh and moreover, the petitioner has criminal antecedents of five serious and similar cases whereas in the present case witnesses have supported the versions of prosecution. In these circumstances, this court is also not inclined to grant

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anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

08. Considering the above facts and circumstances, the anticipatory bail application moved by the petitioner namely Dipak Sahani @ Dipak Kumar is hereby rejected.
