This bail petition is filed on behalf of the petitioner, namely, **Robin Ranjan**, who is in judicial custody since 26.05.2026 in connection with Muffasil P.S. Case No. 327 of 2026 u/ss 103(1), 61(2) and 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

In para-2 of the bail petition, it is mentioned that no other regular or anticipatory bail petition has been filed by the petitioner either in this Court or before the Hon'ble Patna High Court. As per para-3 of the bail petition, the petitioner has no criminal antecedent and as per para-4 of the bail petition, the petitioner is in judicial custody since 26.05.2026.

The prosecution's case, in brief, the daughter of the informant, Rimmi Kumari was pursuing her studies at Motihari Engineering College while staying in a women's hostel. She had repeatedly complained that the hostel environment was not safe and the college officials allegedly allowed unknown outsiders into the hostel and harassed the female students. On the night of 20.05.2026, she informed her father (informant) and mother over the phone that hostel environment had become unbearable and she was speaking secretly, after which the call was abruptly disconnected. On 21.05.2026, the informant received a call from the college stating that his daughter was unwell. Upon reaching Sadar Hospital, Motihari, he found her dead. He noticed a black mark on her neck, swelling around her mouth and red marks on her hands. Looking at her, it appeared that she had been murdered by strangulation. The informant further alleged that the college authorities attempted to suppress the incident by influencing officials and offering money to prevent the lodging of an F.I.R.

The learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has committed no offence. The petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. and there is no allegation whatsoever leveled against him in the F.I.R. The entire allegation of the informant is directed against the administration of Engineering

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College. The prosecution case against the petitioner is based merely on suspicion arising from telephonic contact with the deceased.

The learned Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the State has opposed the prayer for bail.

Heard both sides and perused the record and case diary. From perusal of the record, it appears that the F.I.R. is registered against unknown but the name of the petitioner surfaced in this case during the course of investigation. As per para-18 of the case diary, the police examined the laptop of the deceased and found some whatsapp chats between the mobile number of deceased and mobile nos. 6299821418 saved in the name of Papa and 9102622291 saved in the name of BFF which suggest to the police that there was a love affair between the deceased and the holder of above said mobile numbers and due to breakup between them the deceased Rimmi Kumari died. As per para-19 of the case diary, police obtained the CDR and SDR of the above said mobile numbers and found the holder of the said mobile number to be Robin Ranjan (petitioner) and on that basis police reached at Motihari Engineering College and verified the name of the petitioner as he is the student of that college. As per para-2 of the case diary containing inquest report, death appears to have been caused by hanging. As per para-04 and 08 of the case diary, the informant in his restatement and the witness has corroborated the version of F.I.R. As per para-29 of the case diary, the witness Dr. Navnit Kumar, Principal, has stated that the deceased's room was opened by breaking the door from outside and found her hanging with ceiling fan and thereafter she was brought to Sadar Hospital, Motihari where the doctor declared her dead. The witness Guriya Kumari, in para-30 of the case diary, has also stated the same thing as stated by the witness in para-29 of the case diary. As per para-48 of the case diary, the cause of death has been found to be asphyxia due to hanging caused by ligature material. As per para- 57 of the case diary, the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. As per para-58 of the case diary, the investigation is under progress.

In the facts of the case and keeping in view the nature of allegation, gravity of offence and materials available in the case diary, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the prayer for bail of petitioner, namely, **Robin Ranjan** stands **rejected**.
