**Anticipatory Bail Petition No. 4524 of 2025**

**ORDER**

- 12-03-2026 1. Heard, Sri Anuj Kumar learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri Subhash Chandra Pd. Yadav learned Addl. P.P. appearing on behalf of the prosecution.
2. The petitioner above named seeks pre-arrest bail who apprehends his arrest in connection with Kesariya P.S. Case No. 232 of 2024 registered under Sections 409, 420, 384, 504, 506/34 of IPC.
3. The case of prosecution in brief is that informant Anjeet Kumar is the proprietor of Baba Galas, who received an order from the District Education Officer in the Motihari Education Department, Letter No. 7, dated 04/01/2024, to supply plates for children in government schools in Kesaria Block. In the order of the above work, his agency Baba Glass supplied plates to various schools. Meanwhile, the bill for the plates supplied by Mohammad Imran Alam, working as his staff, was fraudulently paid to the headmasters by the employee Imran and Shahid Alam @ Bablu (Petitioner) , with the intention of embezzlement, under a conspiracy, the government money was fraudulently withdrawn. The said government money was withdrawn in the name of M/S GREEN INDIA STELL FOUNTURIE UDYOG. The proprietor of the said agency M/S GREEN INDIA STELL FOUNTURIE UDYOG is Shahid Alam @ Bablu. Mohammad Imran, who fraudulently defrauded the headmasters and took the payment of the said amount in the account of account number- 50486440990, IFSC CODE-IDIB000M519, branch Madhopur INDIAN BANK, police station- Turkaulia. When his staff member Uday Patel went to the school to pay for the plate supplied, his staff member Uday Patel was told by headmaster that the amount had been paid through RTGS/NEFT in the account of M/S GREEN INDIA STELL FOUNTURIE UDYOG by Mohammad Imran and Shahid Alam@ Bablu (petitioner). When the informant asked Imran, he was abused and threatened with death. The informant was also threatened that if he complain about this to the department or the police station, they will be killed. If you want to do any work in East Champaran district, you will have to pay me Rs 2 lakh per month as extortion, otherwise be ready to face the consequences. Since then the informant am

very scared and terrified.

4. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that no any other bail petition either anticipatory or regular bail petition has ever been filed either before this Court or before the Hon'ble High Court. Petitioner has seven criminal antecedents i.e. 1. Turkauliya P.S. Case No. 275/2020, 2. Turkauliya P.S. Case No. 387/2020, 3. Turkauliya P.S. Case No. 591/2021, 4. Turkauliya P.S. Case No. 324/2020, 5. Turkauliya P.S. Case No. 724/2020, 6. Turkauliya P.S. Case No. 189/2024 and 7. Turkauliya P.S. Case No. 980/2023. He is innocent and has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case malafidely. He is a government contractor of company M/S Green India Steel who works on government tender and the payment details which is being mentioned in formal FIR was the payment received for work done on government tender. Both parties have compromised the case.

5. On the other hand, ld. Addl.P.P. has opposed the prayer of the bail of the petitioner.

6. Heard, both the sides and perused the case record along with documents available on the case record. From perusal of the same it transpires that on typed petition of informant Anjeet Kumar a formal FIR bearing Kesariya P.S. Case No. 232 of 2024 has been registered under Section 409, 420, 384, 504, 506/34 of IPC with allegation of the accused/petitioner and other co-accused have committed embezzlement of government money fraudulently. From perusal of para 3, 6 & 7 of the case diary, informant and other prosecution witnesses have supported the prosecution story. In para 61 of the case diary the present case is found true against the accused petitioner and other co-accused u/s 409,420/34 IPC. In para 3 of the bail petition accused-petitioner has seven criminal which is mentioned in the case diary. Moreover, investigation of this case is still going on.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of this case, nature and gravity of offences, I am not inclined to give privilege of pre-arrest bail to the accused-petitioner. Accordingly, the anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of accused-petitioner namely, Shahid Alam @ Md. Bablu stands Rejected.
