**ORDER**

This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the above named petitioner, who apprehending his arrest in connection with Patahi P.S. Case No. 196 of 2025, U/s- 137(2), 87, 3(5) of B.N.S.

Heard, the Ld. counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner and Ld. P.P. I/c on behalf of State/O.P..

The case of the prosecution as stated by the informant in brief is that on 25.04.2025 at about 06:30 AM informant daughter went to natural call, in the meanwhile all the F.I.R. named accused persons including this petitioner kidnapped his daughter for the purpose of marriage.

Ld. counsel appearing on behalf of accused petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. No other regular or anticipatory bail petition has ever been filed on behalf of the petitioner either before this court or any superior court. Petitioner has one criminal antecedent. Further it has been submitted that petitioner has nothing to do with alleged occurrence as given in the F.I.R. He is ready to abide all the terms and conditions imposed by the court.

On other hand, Ld. P.P(I/C) has vehemently opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Heard both sides and perused the record. From perusal of the certified copy of F.I.R. as well as case diary, it transpires that there is an allegation against the petitioner that he along with co-accused persons had kidnapped the informant's minor daughter and present accused petitioner is also involved in the said occurrence. The witnesses examined during

the course of investigation have corroborated the version of F.I.R. Victim is a minor girl as mentioned in para 38 of case diary. The allegation brought against the petitioner is serious in nature.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, and nature and gravity of the offence alleged, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the above named accused petitioner and accordingly, this anticipatory bail petition is hereby **rejected**.
