Case Called out. Attendance on behalf of the plaintiff has been filed. Record is put up for order on the petition dated 27-11-2025, filed by the plaintiff under section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (hereinafter called as "CPC") with prayer to reopen the evidence of the plaintiff.
