**ANTICIPATORY BAIL PETITION No. 318/2026**

An anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of the accused/petitioners, who are apprehending their arrest, in connection with **Alipur P.S. Case No. 136/2023**, for the offences registered **U/s. 341, 323, 307, 354, 379, 504/34 of the IPC, pending in the Court of Ld. A.C.J.M.-V, Gayaji.**

2. Heard both the sides on the bail application.

3. Learned defence counsel, submitted that prior to this, the petitioners have not filed either anticipatory or regular bail petition before this Court or the Hon'ble Patna High Court. It is further submitted that petitioners are innocent, committed no offence and have falsely been implicated in this case. Lastly, he submitted that the petitioners having no criminal antecedent. Hence, it is prayed for grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the accused petitioners.

4. Per contra the Ld. A.P.P. appeared on behalf of State opposed the prayer for bail.

5. Prosecution case, in brief, as per fardbeyan of informant is that on 27.08.2023 at about 5.30 P.M. while she went towards north side from her house to see her crops, in the meantime co-accused Kamlain Singh, Sushant Singh and Jaikishun Singh armed with rod, lathi and bamboo came and started abusing her. On protest by the informant, co-accused Kamlain Singh and Sushant Singh with bad intention dashed her and all three accused persons assaulted her with rod, lathi and bamboo, due to which she sustained injuries. Thereafter accused Bibha Kumari, Jaya Kumari and Fulwa Devi armed with danda came there and at the sametime informant's brother-in-law came to save her but both were also assaulted by the accused persons, due to which informant fell down on the ground in

unconscious condition and Sudama Singh also received injury. Accused also snatched golden Jitia from the informant.

6. Heard both the parties and perused the material available on record. From perusal, it appears that petitioners are named in the F.I.R., allegation against the petitioners are of assaulting informant and his family member and caused them injured. Injury report of injured Bindu Devi and Sudama Singh are available at para 32 & 33 of the case diary, the same have been found simple in nature caused by hard and blunt objects. Vide para 52 of the case diary notice U/S 41(A) of Cr.P.C. was served to the petitioners. Vide para 55 of the case diary, on compliance of notice issued to them U/S 41(A) of Cr.P.C. they appeared before the police and they were released on police bond. Vide para 57 of the case diary, charge-sheet has been submitted against the accused petitioners after completion of investigation against them. Petitioners claimed to have clean antecedent vide para 03 of their bail petition.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and other material available on record, this court thinks it fit to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Accordingly, it is directed that in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Ld. Court below within three weeks from the date of this order, the petitioners shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each. This direction for anticipatory bail is subject to all the conditions stipulated u/s. 438 (2) of Cr.P.C.
