By moving this miscellaneous petition, the ld. counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that petitioner is an accused of the case being Chakand P.S. Case No. 124/2020. He further submits that five session cases viz. (i) Str. No. 720/2022, (ii) Str. No. 268/2022, (iii) Str. No. 269/2022, (iv) Str. No. 326/2022 and (iv) Str. No. 14/2021 arising out of same case are pending in different courts and prays that all cases should be kept in one court.

Pursuant to the order dated 11.03.2026, a report has been submitted by the Sessions Clerk, in which it has been reported that (i) Str. No. 720/2022, (ii) Str. No. 268/2022, (iii) Str. No. 269/2022, (iv) Str. No. 326/2022 have arisen of the same case being Chakand P.S. Case No. 124/2020 and they all are pending in the court of ld. Addl.S.J.- 3, Gayaji, whereas (iv) Str. No. 14/2021 is not related with same case as has been claimed in this miscellaneous application.

In view of aforesaid report, no order can be passed as it is not maintainable.
