The present petition for anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioner Arun Ravidas apprehending his arrest in connection with Mufassil P.S. Case No. 769/2025 registered for the offence punishable under section 87 of the BNS.

Ld. counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner happens to be the husband of the daughter of the informant.

Ld. counsel further submits that both the parties are major and competent to take a decision with regard to their marriage and they have voluntarily married each other and are living together as husband and wife and in such circumstances, no offence is made out under section 87 of the BNS. He further contends that since the informant did not approve their marriage, the present case has been got instituted.

Ld. counsel further submits that as per the matriculation certificate, the date of birth of the informant's daughter has been referred to as 03.02.2005, which establishes that the informant's daughter was major at the time of her marriage, hence the prayer for anticipatory bail of this petitioner may be considered favourably.

Finding force in the submission advanced by ld. counsel appearing for the petitioner that the petitioner and the victim Sonali Kumari are major and have already married and are living together as husband and wife, the prayer for anticipatory bail of this petitioner is hereby **allowed**. It is directed that the petitioner in the event of arrest or surrender before the court concerned within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of **Rs.25,000/-** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court concerned with condition as laid down u/s 482 of the BNSS with additional condition that:
