The present petition for anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioners Bhushan Yadav, Sunita Devi and Ankit Kumar @ Golu apprehending their arrest in connection with Wazirganj P.S. Case No. 796/2025 registered for the offences punishable under sections 126(2), 115(2), 74, 303(2), 352 and 3(5) of the BNS.

Ld. counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that on account of some petty matter, both the parties had an altercation resulting in institution of this case. He further submits that during the course of free fight both the parties sustained some insignificant injuries but the fact remains to be that there was absolutely no intention to cause death or to cause any significant injury to anyone.

Ld. counsel further submits that in respect of the same incident two cases were got registered and the petitioners carry no criminal antecedents. He further submits that the petitioners are falsely dragged in this case, hence the prayer for anticipatory bail of these petitioners may be considered favourably.

Ld. P.P. has also been heard in opposition to the prayer for bail.

I have considered the submissions as advanced by the parties and have perused the case diary incorporating the injury report. Upon

perusal of the case diary, more specifically Para-45, it appears that the injury appears to be simple in nature caused by hard and blunt substance.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of these petitioners is hereby **allowed**. It is directed that the petitioners in the event of arrest or surrender before the court concerned within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order, the petitioners are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of **Rs.30,000/-** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court concerned with condition as laid down u/s 482 of the BNSS.
