Case called out.

None appeared for the appellant even on repeated call.

Perused the record.

It transpires that this criminal appeal has been filed by the complainant against the order and judgement dated 29.08.2024 passed by Id. Kalpana Bharti, J.M.F.C. Sherghati in connection with Complaint Case No. 375/2017 whereby accused persons were acquitted of all the charges.

It further transpires that this criminal appeal has been filed on 18.02.2025. This case has remained unattended by the appellant since 20.02.2025 i.e. from the very first day scheduled for hearing. As many as twenty three dates have passed but the appellant did not turn up for hearing. Today also none appeared for the appellant on repeated call. This case is still pending at the stage of hearing on admission.

The Id. P.P. submits that appellant has not been turning up for hearing for a very long time. The Id. P.P. also expresses his view that no useful purpose would be served to keep this criminal appeal pending any further and it may be dismissed for default.

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This court is of the view that despite grant of repeated opportunities since 20.02.2025, the appellant has not been turning up for hearing. It appears that appellant has lost his interest in pursuing this case and as such keeping this appeal pending any further would not serve any useful purpose.

In view of aforesaid, this criminal appeal is dismissed for default.
