An anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of above named accused/petitioners, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with **Panchanpur P.S. Case No. 142/2024**, for the offences registered U/s. **126(2), 127(2), 115(2), 303(2), 76, 109, 352, 351(3), 3(5) of the BNS, pending in the Court of Ld. ACJM-VIII, Gaya.**

Heard both the sides on the bail application.

Learned defence counsel, submitted that prior to this, the petitioners have not filed either anticipatory or regular bail petition before this Court or the Hon'ble Patna High Court. It is further submitted that petitioners are innocent, committed no offence and have falsely been implicated in this case. That counter blast of this case has also been lodged by the petitioner parties vide Panchanpur P.S. Case No. 144/2024. It is further submitted that Petitioners were not present in the village at the alleged date and time of occurrence, rather they were on their duty and hence after investigation and supervision of higher police officer submitted final showing not sent up but Ld. A.C.J.M.-VIII, Gaya has been pleased to take cognizance against all FIR persons. Co-accused persons have already been granted anticipatory bail by the predecessor Court vide AB.P. No. 4230/2024 and 4231/2024, dated 22.01.2025. Lastly, he submitted that the petitioners having no criminal antecedent. Hence, it is prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the accused petitioners.

Per contra the Ld. A.P.P. appeared on behalf of State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Prosecution case, in brief, as per informant is that on 04.11.2024 at about 7.30 A.M. he was at door of his house and his nephew aged about 6 years went out on nature's call, in the meantime co-accused Dipu Kumar came on Motorcycle and dashed his nephew without blowing horn. Then

informant scolded him. After sometime accused petitioners along with other co-accused persons came, assaulted him with fist and slaps, took him to their house. They further assaulted him with lathi, due to which he sustained injuries. On alarm, his family members rushed to save him but they were also assaulted by the accused petitioners, resultantly they also sustained injuries. One of the co-accused tried to outrage the modesty of informant's wife and also snatched her golden chain from her.

Heard both the parties and perused the material available on record. From perusal, it appears that petitioners are named in the F.I.R. The allegation against the petitioners of assaulting informant and his family members. The injury report of injured are available at para 67 & 84 of the case diary, have been found simple in nature. From perusal of para 35 of the case diary, it appears that the case was not found true against the accused petitioners by the Investigation Officer. Vide para 92 of the case diary, charge-sheet has been submitted against the other co-accused persons showing the accused petitioners innocent, but cognizance has been taken against the petitioners vide order dated 10.10.2025. Counter case of this case has also been lodged by the petitioners. Petitioners claimed to have clean antecedent vide para 03 of their bail petition. Moreover anticipatory bail of other co-accused persons have already been granted by the predecessor Court.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and other materials on record, this court thinks it fit to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Accordingly, it is directed that in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Ld. Court below within a month from the date of this order, the petitioners shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each. This direction for anticipatory bail is subject to all the conditions stipulated u/s. 482 of BNSS.
