An anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of the above named accused/petitioners, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with ***Vishnupad P.S. Case No. 37/2026*** , for the offences registered **U/s. 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 329(4), 76, 303(2), 351(3), 352, 3(5) of the BNS, pending in the Court of Ld. A.C.J.M.-VI, Gayaji.**

2. Heard both the sides on the bail application.
3. Learned defence counsel, submitted that prior to this, the petitioners have not filed either anticipatory or regular bail petition before this Court or before the Hon'ble Patna High Court. It is further submitted that petitioners are innocent, committed no offence and have falsely been implicated in this case. It is further submitted that there is no specific allegations against the petitioners. It is also submitted that there is case and counter case. It is further submitted that case has been compromised between both the parties and certified copy of compromise petition has been filed. Lastly he submitted that petitioners having no criminal antecedent. Hence, it is prayed to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the accused petitioners.
4. Per contra the Ld. A.P.P. appeared on behalf of State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail but he conceded that both parties have compromised this case outside the Court and compromise petition has been filed and today informant of this case is also present in the Court and admitted the factom of compromise.

5. Prosecution case, in brief, as per informant is that on 24.01.2026 in the morning she was sweeping her room of house, in the meantime accused Bigu Das came, entered into her house and started molesting her. On protesting by the informant, accused Bigu Das called other accused persons who were standing outside of her house into informant's house and ordered the said accused persons to assault the informant. Accused Bigu Das assaulted informant with iron rod, due to which he fell down on the ground. Other accused persons also assaulted her. Accused Akash Kumar snatched golden locket from her. Prior to this occurrence accused persons entered into her house and tried to outrage the modesty of her niece. On alarm, local people came then all accused persons fled away from the spot while issuing threat to informant to commit dacoity in her house and also rape her.

6. Heard both the parties and perused the material available on record. From perusal, it appears that petitioners are named accused in the F.I.R. Allegation against the petitioners are of assaulting the informant and also tried to outrage her modesty. There is case and counter case between the parties. Both parties have compromised this case outside the Court and certified copy of compromise petition has also been filed. Today informant is also present in the Court and admitted the factom of compromise and they have also endorsed their signature on the order-sheet. Petitioners claimed to have clean antecedent vide para 03 of their bail petition.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, other materials on record as well as the fact of compromise between the parties, this court thinks it fit to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Accordingly, it is directed that in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Ld. Court below within a month from the date of this order, the petitioners shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each. This direction for anticipatory bail is subject to all conditions stipulated u/s. 482 of BNSS.
