11.03.2026 File taken up for hearing today on the miscellaneous application has been filed by the Ld. Counsel on behalf of the applicant **Ravindra Kumar S/o Devsharan Yadav** for extension of the time for surrender as time stipulated in the order dated 22.01.2025, while granting the anticipatory bail to the applicant.

It is submitted by the Ld Counsel of the applicant that he could not surrender and furnish his bail bond within 30 days as he went outside of State for his livelihood. Therefore prayed that extension of time may be given to surrender and furnish the bail bond before Ld. Trial court.

Copy of the same has already been supplied to the Ld A.P.P. for the State. Ld. APP considering the circumstances has not opposed the same, however submitted that the same may be allowed with cost.

Heard and perused the material available on record. From perusal, it transpires that on 22.01.2025 the ABP No. 4231/2024 of the applicant **Ravindra Yadav** along with other accused petitioners were allowed and it was directed "***in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of a month from the date of order on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousands) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Concerned Ld. Trial Court, Gaya in connection with " Panchanpur P.S. Case No. 142/2024"***", however the applicant could not surrender and furnish his bail bond within time as per directions and today filed an application.

Considering the facts and circumstances, this criminal miscellaneous application is **allowed**. He is given further 15 days more from today to surrender and furnish his bail bond before the Ld. Trial Court, rest of the conditions would be remained as it is.

Accordingly, the present Criminal Miscellaneous application is disposed of with above observations.

Copy of this order be sent to the concerned trial court to proceed in accordance with law.
