A bail application has been filed on behalf of above named accused/petitioner, who is in custody since 20.02.2026, in connection with **Chakand P.S. Case No. 416/2023**, for the offences registered **U/s. 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 379, 385, 386, 504 & 506** of the IPC pending in the Court of **Ld. A.C.J.M.-X, Gaya**.

Heard both the sides on the bail application.

Learned defence counsel submitted that prior to this, the petitioner has not filed either anticipatory or regular bail petition before this Court or the Hon'ble Patna High Court. It is further submitted that that petitioner is innocent, committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that petitioner is not named in the FIR and was not caught on the spot, nor any incriminating article was recovered from his possession. That no one has seen the petitioner in participating in the alleged occurrence. That all the offences levelled in this case areailable except Section 379 & 386 of the I.P.C. which are not attracted against the petitioner because no one has specifically taken the name of the accused petitioner. Lastly, he submitted that the petitioner having four criminal antecedents vide Tekari P.S. Case No. 85/2009, 101/2020, 111/2014 & 274/2017 in which he is on bail in all cases and he is in custody in this case since 20.02.2026. So, it is prayed that he may be released on bail.

Per contra the Ld. A.P.P. appeared on behalf of State opposed the prayer for bail.

The prosecution case, in short, as per informant is that on 14/12/2023, about 15-20 unknown miscreants lashed with arms, reached at the brick-klin of Kanchan Brick kiln (*Bhathha*) and other six

brick kiln (*Bhathha*). They assaulted the Munshi and labourers present there. They snatched their mobile phones and cash from their possession by putting them in fear. They also threatened and prohibited them with instruction not to do work. They demanded ransom and threatened them to kill, if their demand of ransom is not fulfilled by the owners of the *Bhathha*. The miscreants returned back by saying that they are the members of Manoj and Vikash gang.

Heard both the parties and perused the case record. From perusal, it appears that petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. but during investigation his name has surfaced in this case on confessional statement of co-accused. The allegation alleged in the F.I.R. of demanding extortion money from the owner of the brick Kiln (*Bhattha*). Petitioner admitted to have four criminal antecedents vide para 03 of his bail petition. Regular Bail of co-accused persons have been granted by Hon'ble High Court, Patna in Criminal Misc. 25611/2024 and 77420/2024, dated 10.04.2024 and 07.02.2025 respectively.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, I think, it is fit to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, subject to the conditions that:-

(i) Accused petitioner shall filed his bail bond after submission of charge-sheet against him.

(i) One of the bailors shall be a close relative of the petitioner.

(ii) He would not involve in any case in future except this case, otherwise the prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of his bail bond.
