The present petition for anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioners Nitu Devi and Vinay Singh apprehending their arrest in connection with Konch P.S. Case No. 598/2025 registered for the offences punishable under sections 126(2), 115(2), 303(2), 74 and 3(5) of the BNS.

Ld. counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioner and the informant party are *Gotiyas* of each other and some land dispute has been ongoing between them.

Ld. counsel further submits that some petty dispute between the two children of both the families subsequently escalated into an altercation and free fight between both the parties resulting in registration of the present FIR which, in fact, is a counter blast of Konch P.S. Case No. 597/2025 as two cases have been registered in respect of the same incident.

Ld. counsel further submitted that no significant injury has been caused to anyone which is apparent from the contents of the FIR itself and the allegation of snatching of gold chain is a super addition. He further submits that the petitioners carry no criminal antecedents.

Ld. P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the submissions as advanced by the parties, this Court is of the view that the petitioners prayer for anticipatory bail deserves to be considered favourably.

Accordingly, this anticipatory bail application stands **allowed**. It is directed that the petitioners in the event of arrest or surrender before the court concerned within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order, the petitioners are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of **Rs.25,000/-** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court concerned with condition as laid down u/s 482 of the BNSS.
