- 1. This anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of above named accused petitioners who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Mahkar P.S. Case No. 246 of 2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 352, 351(2), 3(5) BNS.
- 2. Sh. Bawan Kumar, the learned advocate appeared on behalf of the accused petitioners. The prosecution is represented by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor.
- 3. The submission of the learned counsel of the accused petitioners is that there is no criminal antecedent against petitioners and further submitted that due to some misunderstanding on small scuffle the F.I.R. was registered. On these grounds a prayer has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the accused petitioners.
- 4. The prosecution story based on the written report of the informant, in brief is that on 15.10.2025 at about 05:15 P.M, while informant was milking his buffalo at home, accused Devendra Yadav armed with club came and abused him. On raising objection by informant, he assaulted him with club causing severe head injury. Hearing alarm accused petitioners also came there and started abusing and threatening the informant. It is further alleged that when he returned home after receiving medical treatment from Mahkar Govt. Hospital, Ankit Kumar called and threatened him from mobile phone no. 9798541953 that if he would lodge any case against him, he and his entire family would be assaulted again.

5. Heard the Ld. A.P.P. and the Ld. Counsel of defence and perused the case record. From perusal of the case record it transpires that, bail of co-accused Devendra Yadav has already been granted by Hon'ble High Court dated 15.01.2026 in Criminal Miscellaneous No. 87902 of 2025. As per injury report of informant available on record, injury of injured person found simple in nature.

6. Considering the above facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the accused petitioners. If the accused petitioners appear before the learned Original Court below within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the order to trial Court, they shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the original court with the statutory conditions particularized u/s 482 (2) of the B.N.S.S.

Accordingly, this anticipatory bail application is hereby **allowed**.
