The present petition for anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of petitioner Satyendra Yadav apprehending his arrest in connection with Barachatty P. S. Case No. 131/2025 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 8(b), 18 and 29 of the NDPS Act.

Ld. counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case merely on the basis of suspicion. He further submits that the petitioner has no concern with the land where opium plants were cultivated and that, the petitioner carries no criminal antecedents.

Ld. Counsel further submits that similarly situated co-accused Arun Kumar Yadav has been granted anticipatory bail vide order dated 16.07.2025 passed by the Hon'ble High Court in Cri. Misc. No. 43527 of 2025 and on that score, another co-accused persons namely Dwarika Yadav @ Dwarka Yadav has also been granted anticipatory bail by this court vide order dated 28.08.2025, passed in Spl ABP No. 76/2025, hence, the prayer for anticipatory bail of this petitioner be also considered favourably.

Ld. P.P. has been heard in opposition to the prayer for bail.

Taking note of the aforesaid, this court does not find any ground or any reason for not entertaining the prayer for anticipatory bail of this petitioner in view of the order passed by the Hon'ble High Court in Cri. Misc. No. 43527 of 2025, dated 16.07.2025 and as such, the prayer for anticipatory bail is hereby **allowed**. It is directed that the petitioner in the event of arrest or surrender before the court concerned within a period of four weeks from today he shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of **Rs.30,000/-** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court concerned with condition as laid down u/s 482 of the BNSS.
