The present petition for anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioners Lakshminiya Devi @ Anshu Kumari, Radha Devi and Jairam Singh apprehending their arrest in connection with Delha P.S. Case No. 54/2024 registered for the offences punishable under sections 448, 342, 323, 380, 504, 506 r/w 34 of the IPC.

Ld. counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that the informant and the petitioners are *Gotiyas* and owing to a prior property dispute, the informant has levelled false allegations and implicated the petitioners.

Ld. counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners were extended protection in terms of section 41 of the Cr.P.C..

Ld. counsel further submits that subsequently after submission of charge-sheet, cognizance has been taken vide order dated 15.11.2025 and summons were issued only on 03.01.2026 after which, the petitioners became aware and hence they approached this Court seeking protection.

Ld. counsel further contends that apprehending that once they appear before the Court concerned, they may be taken into custody, they have made out a case for grant of protection.

Taking note of the aforesaid submissions, particularly the submission that the petitioners were extended protection in terms of section 41 of the Cr.P.C., the prayer for anticipatory bail of these petitioners is hereby **allowed**. It is directed that the petitioners in the event of arrest or surrender before the court concerned within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order, the petitioners are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of **Rs.30,000/-** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court concerned with condition as laid down u/s 482 of the BNSS.
