The present petition for regular bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioner Samod Kumar @ Samod Prasad who is in judicial custody since 02.03.2026 in connection with Dumaria P.S. Case No. 25/2026 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 18, 20 and 22 of the NDPS Act.

Ld. counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has no concern with the alleged offence and in fact he is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case due to dirty village politics.

Ld. counsel further submits that the allegations are based on some local information and in fact, unverified local allegations cannot be treated as ground to prolong the custody.

Ld. counsel further submits that the petitioner has no concern with the land in question where Opium plants were being cultivated and that, the petitioner is languishing in jail since 02.03.2026.

Ld. Spl. P.P. has also been heard in opposition to the prayer for bail.
