The bail petition has been filed and moved on behalf of incarcerated above named accused who are in judicial custody since 17.02.2026, arising of Khizarsarai P.S. Case No.53 of 2026 for committing offence u/s 303(2) of BNS, pending in the Court of Learned Miss Arpita J.M.F.C., Gaya Ji.

Heard Learned Advocate for the petitioners and Learned A.P.P. for the State.

This present case has been instituted by the written information given by the informant namely Prinka Kumari Sharma and she stated that on 11.02.2026 at about 12:30 hr. the informant was going to her house by the tempoo from Khizarsarai market to Gaya and her trolley has taken back of tempoo and when she reached at her house and checked her trolley then gold earring, gold mangalsutra were missing. Hence this case.

The Learned defence counsel humbly submitted that the petitioners have not filed any bail either anticipatory or regular bail petition before this Court or any Hon'ble higher Court. The Learned defence counsel for the petitioners humbly submitted that the petitioners are quite innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case and they have not committed any offence. He further stated that petitioners have not caught on the spot and nothing has been recovered from their conscious possession. Lastly, he submitted that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent and they are in judicial custody since 17.02.2026, so they deserve the privilege of bail.

The Learned A.P.P. opposed the prayer and prayed to dismiss the petition of bail filed by the petitioners.

Heard the Learned Counsels for both the sides and perused the case record along with the CD. From perusal of FIR, it transpires that this case has been instituted for the offence u/s 303(2) of BNS, against the present petitioners who are husband and wife. From perusal of Seizure list it transpires that lost articles, the gold earring and gold mangalsutra were said to be recovered from the house of the petitioners. From perusal of Para No.36 of case diary as well as para No.3 of bail petition, it transpires that present petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Considering the nature of allegation against the petitioners and their custody period, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail. Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, subject to the satisfaction of the learned court below. This direction for bail is also subject to the condition that one of the bailor shall be relative of the petitioners. This direction for bail is further subject to the condition that the petitioners shall fully cooperate in trial of the case and they shall not induce on thereafter the prosecution witnesses also the prosecution is at liberty to move for the cancellation of this bail bonds. This bail application is disposed of accordingly. Nothing stated herein shall tantamount to any expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
