This anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of above named accused/petitioner, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with **Buniyadganj P.S. Case No. 349/2025**, for the offences registered **U/s. 126(2), 115(2), 109, 351(2), 352, 3(5) of the BNS & 27 of the Arms Act, pending in the Court of Ld. A.CJM-VIII, Gaya.**

2. Heard both the sides on the bail application.

3. Learned defence counsel, submitted that prior to this, the petitioner has not filed anticipatory or regular bail petition before this Court or Hon'ble Patna High Court. It is further submitted that petitioner is innocent, committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. It is further submitted that there is no specific allegation against the accused petitioner. The anticipatory bail of co-accused has already been granted by this Court in A.B.P. No. 230/2026, dated 25.02.2026. Lastly he submitted that petitioner having no criminal antecedent. Hence, it is prayed to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4. Per contra the Ld. A.P.P. appeared on behalf of State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

5. Prosecution case, in brief, as per fardbeyan of informant is that on 15.12.2025 at about 8.30 A.M. he was returning to his house from the Alipur Market by his Motorcycle and when reached at Joda Masjid, Head Manpur, he heard sound of gun fire at Dr. Numi's place and in the meantime accused and other co-accused persons R/o Joda Masjid, Head Manpur armed with pistol in their hand came and said to him that *sala Doctor sahab ko bachane aaya hai, aaj goli mar denge.* On this, informant prayed before them that he has no concern with Doctor Sahab but in spite of this, accused Parwez Alam @ Raju assaulted him with butt of pistol, due

to which he received head injury. Then co-accused Taslim Ahmed assaulted him with lathi, due to which he received injury on his back. Thereafter four accused persons including petitioner fired upon him, causing shot in chest and another bullet passed near his ear and a bullet hit his thigh and passed through and went out. On hulla, local people gathered there, then they fled away.

6. Heard both the parties and perused the material available on record. From perusal, it appears that petitioner is named in the F.I.R. Allegation alleged in the F.I.R. against the petitioner is of firing upon the informant with pistol and caused gun shot injury to him. Vide para 120 of the case diary, the injury of injured has been found simple in nature caused by hard and blunt objects. Land dispute is going on between the parties. Vide para 10 of the case diary, after checking the CCTV footage, it has been found that the firing is going on but who is firing is not identified. Petitioner is claimed to have clean antecedent vide para 03 of his bail petition. Anticipatory bail of co-accused Taslim Ahmed has been granted by this Court vide A.B.P. No. 230/2026, dated 25.02.2026 against whom only allegation of assaulting informant with lathi on back but there is specific allegation against the accused petitioner is of firing upon the informant with pistol.

7. Thus, considering the facts and circumstances of the case as discussed above nature of offence, the prayer for anticipatory bail to the petitioner is hereby **disposed of with direction to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court within one month and Ld. Trial Court shall pass an order on merit, on same day without prejudice of this order.**
