The present petition for anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioner Ram Kishore Singh who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Complaint Case No.1642/2015 registered for the offences punishable under section 420 of the IPC.

Prosecution case, in brief, as per S.A., is that the accused persons did not execute the rest 15 decimal land pertains in Khata No.86 and plot No.1292. It is further alleged that total Rs.52,500/- was given to the accused persons. It is further alleged that in the year 2014, the said land has been executed in the name of Lala Sao.

Ld. counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that the petitioner had no knowledge about the issuance of processes being 82 and 83 Cr.P.C. and after getting knowledge, the petitioner filed Cri. Rev. No.67/2025 against the orders dated 10.11.2017 to 05.03.2025 passed by the Ld. Court below and the Ld. Sessions Judge, Gayaji has been pleased to allow the Cri. Rev. No.67/2025 vide order dated 16.01.2026 and set aside the coercive orders. He further submits that there is no written agreement in regard to sale and purchase of 15 decimal land. He further submits that there is no specific allegation against this petitioner.

Ld. P.P has also been heard.

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I have considered the submissions as advanced by the parties and have perused the case record. The present case was brought in the year 2015, alleging that the petitioner took money to execute land to the complainant but he sold the said land to other person. After further perusal of case record, it appears that there is no agreement paper available on the record. It further appears that the complaint case has been brought against Ram Kishore Singh, Ramadhar Singh, Pawan Kumar and Lala Sao and cognizance has been taken vide order dated 02.03.2017 against Ram Kishore Singh and Ramadhar Singh.

Considering the aforesaid submissions, the petitioner is directed to appear before the court concerned within a period of four weeks from today whereupon he shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court concerned with condition as laid down u/s 482 of the BNSS.
